**Antitrust Modernization Commission Selects Initial Slate of Issues for Study.**

January 18, 2005 – The Antitrust Modernization Commission has selected an initial slate of twenty-five issues to study further pursuant to its statutory mandate to examine whether the need exists to modernize the antitrust laws. The selection was made in the course of a public meeting in Washington, D.C., the third such meeting held by the Commission. The Commission Chair, Deborah Garza, made it clear that the initial list of issues is not preclusive and that additional issues may be taken up at a later time. The Commission will announce plans for further work on these issues at a later date.
