Panel wants public input on health care

Members of the Citizens' Health Care Working Group are headed to Salt Lake City and want to hear your ideas for reshaping America's health care system. Created in 2003 under legislation co-sponsored by Sen. Orrin Hatch, R-Utah, the group is traveling to cities across the country seeking input from citizens on how to improve the delivery of health care. The group then intends to make these recommendations to Congress. The group's research has included a trip to LDS Hospital in Salt Lake City. The president is also expected to respond to these recommendations. A free public meeting will be Saturday at the Salt Lake City Marriott Downtown, 75 South West Temple, from 8 a.m. to noon.
