

1 CHAIRPERSON JAMES: Do we have a campaign finance  
2 language proposal? Has it been distributed? If you would  
3 distribute that.

4 COMMISSIONER LEONE: A dash after entities and before  
5 that. Instead of commas, after entities, dash, corporate, private  
6 or tribal, dash.

7 COMMISSIONER BIBLE: So in California, as Commissioner  
8 McCarthy pointed out, the tribe, because they've not applied for  
9 and granted approval to be operating gambling casinos, they could  
10 --

11 COMMISSIONER LEONE: That's true. I think --

12 COMMISSIONER WILHELM: I don't mean to interrupt,  
13 Richard. I would respectfully disagree with that. Every tribe in  
14 California has asked for a compact.

15 COMMISSIONER BIBLE: And they're in negotiation now  
16 with --

17 COMMISSIONER LEONE: I've just learned to assume that  
18 Bill Bible was right.

19 COMMISSIONER WILHELM: He usually is.

20 CHAIRPERSON JAMES: Is someone prepared to offer this  
21 as a motion?

22 COMMISSIONER McCARTHY: I'll offer it.

23 CHAIRPERSON JAMES: Is there a second?

24 COMMISSIONER BIBLE: Second.

25 CHAIRPERSON JAMES: It has been moved and seconded.  
26 Discussion? The question has been called. All in favor?  
27 Opposed? Abstentions? I think the ayes have it, but maybe just  
28 to be safe -- did we get three nos? They ayes have it. Let's  
29 have a vote. Commissioner Bible?

1 COMMISSIONER BIBLE: No.

2 CHAIRPERSON JAMES: Commissioner Dobson?

3 COMMISSIONER DOBSON: Aye.

4 CHAIRPERSON JAMES: Commissioner Lanni?

5 COMMISSIONER LANNI: Aye.

6 CHAIRPERSON JAMES: Commissioner Leone?

7 COMMISSIONER LEONE: Aye.

8 CHAIRPERSON JAMES: Commissioner Loescher?

9 COMMISSIONER LOESCHER: No.

10 CHAIRPERSON JAMES: Commissioner McCarthy?

11 COMMISSIONER McCARTHY: Aye.

12 CHAIRPERSON JAMES: Commissioner Moore?

13 COMMISSIONER MOORE: Aye.

14 CHAIRPERSON JAMES: Commissioner Wilhelm?

15 COMMISSIONER WILHELM: No.

16 CHAIRPERSON JAMES: Commissioner James, Aye. There are  
17 no abstentions, so that's six to four.

18 COMMISSIONER MOORE: If it's six to four . . .

19 CHAIRPERSON JAMES: We have -- now those are new  
20 recommendations, are they not, Jim? Are we finished with all of  
21 the olds that people were working on? Director Kelly?

22 DR. KELLY: Madam Chair, we also have these two. What  
23 about future research?

24 CHAIRPERSON JAMES: This is my question. My question  
25 is there are new recommendations that commissioners have brought  
26 forward. I'm prepared to move to that now if there is no further  
27 discussion on any tabled matters or 00

28 DR. KELLY: Future research.

29 CHAIRPERSON JAMES: I have been asked to delay that one

1 because they're still working on it until later today. Is that  
2 the case?

3 COMMISSIONER McCARTHY: Madam Chair, we have a  
4 unanimous recommendation from the research subcommittee, but it is  
5 not printed up yet for members of the commission to view. So for  
6 that reason we have a delay and we appreciate it.

7 CHAIRPERSON JAMES: That would be fine.

8 CHAIRPERSON JAMES: With that then we will move to --  
9 does everybody have a copy of the language that was passed on  
10 campaign finance? People seem to be needing that. Can I ask  
11 staff to get additional copies for distribution to the public?  
12 We'll get -- thank you. With that then we will move to new  
13 recommendations. Commissioner Dobson, we'll start with you.

14 COMMISSIONER DOBSON: I have two items that were  
15 expressed in a letter to Dr. Kelly on May the 21st. I think you  
16 have a copy of it in front of you. I am suggesting that we  
17 consider these two items that were before us in a recent meeting  
18 but were not voted on. I am asking the Commission to consider it  
19 again. Neither of them, I don't think, is controversial, although  
20 you never know with this Commission.

21 COMMISSIONER LANNI: Point of information.

22 COMMISSIONER DOBSON: Pardon?

23 COMMISSIONER LANNI: Point of information. When you  
24 say they weren't considered, does that mean that you proposed them  
25 and they didn't receive a second?
