

1 COMMISSIONER WILHELM: The last piece of this packet is
2 the last one, two -- last six pieces, beginning with the typed
3 page headed, "Technology and the future of gambling." This is
4 really just a -- the structural thing that we already passed. The
5 suggestion is that it leads from the technology chapter, all of
6 this stuff, that it relocates certain paragraphs to certain
7 chapters. I have to admit that Eric and I ran out of gas, that we
8 didn't suggest where to relocate them.

9 And I would also point out finally that on the next to
10 last page of the packet -- I'm sorry, the third to last page in
11 the packet, one of the things that we suggested to relocate is a
12 section from "Technology and the Future of Gambling" draft page
13 16, entitled "VLTs and the Pari-mutuel Industry." We didn't try
14 to re-write this paragraph, but it also has this confusion about
15 the terminology of VLT. So, I just thought I'd mention that. So,
16 the only thing to act on is the -- of the structural thing, merely
17 to point out that something has to happen with these remaining
18 sections.

19 CHAIRPERSON JAMES: And you have no recommendations as
20 to where they should go? I have a couple.

21 COMMISSIONER LANNI: John, in that last section, if you
22 replace VLTs with EGDs, does that work?

23 COMMISSIONER WILHELM: That works, I believe. Yes. I
24 think it does. And that's just a question of where to put it.

25 COMMISSIONER LEONE: Maybe this is --

26 CHAIRPERSON JAMES: Can I ask you to take a look at
27 that tonight and make a suggestion tomorrow morning as to where
28 you would relocate those remaining paragraphs?

29 COMMISSIONER LEONE: Can't really -- I'd rather do

1 that.

2 CHAIRPERSON JAMES: That's right.

3 COMMISSIONER LANNI: I think just for formality, we
4 need an amendment to your proposal here. I'd like to amend that
5 that section on page 16 of the report referred to as "VLT and the
6 Pari-mutuel Industry", that wherever there's a reference to VLTs
7 that they be replaced with EGDs.

8 CHAIRPERSON JAMES: Is there a second?

9 COMMISSIONER LEONE: Second.

10 CHAIRPERSON JAMES: All in favor?

11 Any opposed?

12 Any abstentions?

13 COMMISSIONER LANNI: Move for the --

14 CHAIRPERSON JAMES: I think that was sort of by
15 acclamation. We already -- we can vote again. That's all right.
16 Would you like -- do you move that?

17 Question?

18 All in favor?

19 Any opposed?

20 COMMISSIONER WILHELM: I would just point out for the
21 comfort, some small degree of comfort, that having dealt with that
22 packet there's a whole bunch of stuff in the chapter that we now
23 have to address, that it's therefore already double.

24 CHAIRPERSON JAMES: That's a good point. With that,
25 then, let's turn to chapter one, "The Overview."

26 COMMISSIONER LOESCHER: Just for the sake of formulating
27 that, the executive summary will be looked at some other time?

28 CHAIRPERSON JAMES: Yeah. I said first thing this
29 morning that we would do the executive summary at the end, because

1 what we do with each of these chapters will then shape what that
2 executive summary looks like.

3 COMMISSIONER WILHELM: I might also add procedurally,
4 okay, and I apologize for this.

5 CHAIRPERSON JAMES: That's okay.

6 COMMISSIONER WILHELM: When -- when Dr. Kelly asked
7 Eric and I last night for copies of the changes that we wish to
8 submit, that I wish to submit, we had a minor misunderstanding.
9 We only gave him the changes for the chapters that are on today's
10 agenda. We do have some additional changes that are on chapters
11 tomorrow. In particular, the executive summary. So, we'll give
12 you those today, and I apologize for not having distributed them.

14 COMMISSIONER BIBLE: For the record, I have been saying
15 they'll be distributed by the end of today's session.

16 CHAIRPERSON JAMES: That would be good. I think our
17 time tomorrow would be much more productive if we could have all
18 of those in tonight, copied, and to the Commissioners, and then
19 things should go --

20 COMMISSIONER BIBLE: I apologize.

21 CHAIRPERSON JAMES: Oh, that's all right.

22 Okay. First one -- I would ask Commissioners to please
23 identify yours as they come up, because with the cover memos
24 having been removed, we have no way of knowing where they came
25 from. The first one up is on page five, paragraph three, last
26 line. Who's change is that?
