CHAIRPERSON JAMES: Nadine, can I ask you to pull4 that right up close. Thanks.

5 MS. EVANS: I'm Nadine Evans. I'm a single mother 6 of three children. I'm a guest room attendant at the Mirage 7 I came to Las Vegas in 1992 from Reno, Nevada, where I Casino. worked various jobs trying to make above minimum wages. 8 Ι 9 worked as a keno runner and writer making \$6.75 an hour. My 10 family and I could not afford the medical insurance because I 11 could not afford to do the deductible. We went without 12 insurance for a number of years.

By moving to Las Vegas and getting a union job in the gaming industry, I made better wages and I'm able to put money aside for emergencies. I'm able to help with my grandchildren's future education, and I'm also able to take vacations that I could not take before on \$6.75 an hour.

I'm also happy to say now I can go to the doctor because I have insurance that I can afford, and by working in the gaming industry I have a much better life. Thank you.
