1 CHAIRMAN JAMES: Our first panel this morning is 2 Gambling and the National Economy. Commissioner Leone 3 recommended that we invite a panel of experts to discuss the 4 economic impacts on a national scale.

5 Our efforts to accomplish this goal have been very 6 challenging. Staff have experienced tremendous difficulty 7 identifying a body of information and a list of experts qualified 8 to address the national economic impacts of legalized gambling. 9 It would appear to date that this question has not been very 10 widely studied.

11 Consequently, there seems to be a void in the 12 available body of research in this area but today we will begin 13 to attempt to fill that void. Would the speakers please come 14 forward as I call your names? And keep in mind, as witnesses before a Federal commission, you are presumed to be speaking 15 16 under oath and please remember to keep your remarks to 15 17 minutes.

18 I would also remind you that all of your testimony 19 has been submitted in written form, and if you'd like to 20 summarize those remarks, that would be entirely appropriate.

21 Joining us this morning are Mr. Jason Ader, Senior 22 Managing Director, Bear, Stearns and Company; Dr. William Thompson, Chairman and Professor, University of Nevada at Las 23 Comer, Managing Partner, Arthur 24 Mr. Steve Andersen Veqas; 25 Consultants; Dr. Timothy Ryan from the College of Business 26 Administration at the University of New Orleans. And we will 27 begin in that order.
