- 1 CHAIRPERSON JAMES: Again I'd like to thank our
- 2 presenters this afternoon for their patience and thank you for
- 3 being here. Mr. Finnegan, Mr. Scheppach, we are most anxious to
- 4 hear your recommendations to this Commission, but before we get
- 5 started, Commissioner Loescher has requested of the Chair to have
- 6 a couple of minutes to make a comment. And then we'll get right
- 7 to your presentation.
- 8 Commissioner Loescher?
- 9 COMMISSIONER LOESCHER: Yes. Thank you very much,
- 10 Madam Chair. And I appreciate this diversion from the agenda a
- 11 little bit. I would like just to clarify the record a little
- 12 bit.
- 13 There are 198 compacts, as opposed to the 168 that was
- 14 quoted by ACIR.
- The other is that I made inquiry to the Bureau of
- 16 Indian Affairs and the National Indian Gaming Commission within
- 17 the last hour. And I am told that if they dial Mr. George
- 18 Skibine, (202) 273-3153 by fax or telephone, (202) 219-4066 --
- 19 CHAIRPERSON JAMES: Is anyone from ACIR in the room at
- 20 this point?
- 21 COMMISSIONER LOESCHER: I was just saying this for the
- 22 record, that they can make a call. Madam Chairman, they can make
- 23 a call, and they will get all of the compacts and the ordinances
- 24 they want.
- 25 There will be a fee for the duplication. It will cost
- 26 them somewhere between three and six thousand dollars to get this

- 1 information. But it is available, and there is no problem to get
- 2 it.
- So, for the record, I just wanted to offer that for the
- 4 Commission.
- 5 CHAIRPERSON JAMES: Thank you.
- 6 COMMISSIONER WILHELM: Maybe we should give
- 7 Commissioner Loescher a cut of the ACIR fee.
- 8 CHAIRPERSON JAMES: Thank you.

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
