

1 CHAIR JAMES: I asked Commissioner Kelly
2 is he could just step forward a second and just give
3 us a little bit of update on where we are with our
4 ACIR research.

5 EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR KELLY: Madame Chair,
6 Commissioners, as you know, about three weeks ago we
7 sent a letter to ACIR informing them that we were not
8 satisfied with one of the three components that they
9 had produced for us; that, in fact, as far as we were
10 concerned, that particular component constituted a
11 breach of contract.

12 I believe that they're exploring legal
13 options at this time. One of the three components,
14 however, that we were still looking forward to was due
15 the 15th of this month, three days ago, and that was
16 the electronic compilation of all statutes and
17 regulations.

18 That did not arrive. I received a call
19 left on my voice mail yesterday from ACIR saying that
20 they were working on it and that it would be available
21 as of this Thursday. So that is where it stands.

22 COMMISSIONER DOBSON: Lots of luck.
