8 report back to the rear table where you signed in and you will  
9 given instructions so that we can do this quickly and smoothly.  
10 So if you are signed up to give public comment, please go to the  
11 rear table where you originally signed in and they will give you  
12 instructions there.

14 set up for public comment. Thank you.

23 yellow light indicates one minute remaining, and the red light is  
24 your signal to stop. If you are ready, we are prepared to hear  
25 our first speaker.
