Dear Sirs:

This letter is to urge that the members of the panel with a conflict of interest, such as Charles Rossotti, ex-IRS commissioner whose company supplied millions of dollars worth of computers and programs to the IRS, resign.

The IRS presently sends out Notices of Levy and Notices of Federal Tax lien to various clerks of court and companies such as financial institutions, stock brokerage firms, etc. The IRS has never been delegated the authority to send out these notices. The IRS sends out the Notices of Levy without signing them under penalty of perjury, as required by the IRC. The statement on the back of the Notice of Levy that supposedly gives the IRS' authority for mailing the notice and demanding money from the receiver is supposed to have the line that informs the receiver that the notice is applicable to only government employees. However, that line is deleted.
