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7 President's Advisory Panel on Federal Tax Reform

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12 Dear Sirs:

13 The present system that was drafted by our fore fathers worked relatively well from 1776 to 1931. In
14 1931, our legeslators were alarmed. With only three percent of the people paying Income Tax, there
15 were excess funds in the U S Treasury. In order to divest those funds, the Legislators went on the open
16 market to purchase government Bonds.

17 Those required to pay income tax are Government Employees, Owners of Corporations and Foreigners
18 living here earning income as defined by our founding fathers. See Blacks Law for definition of
19 Income. *The gain derived from capitol, from labor or effort, or both combined, including profit or gain*
20 *through sale or conversion of capitol.* Ones compensation earned from labor is not a Profit, according to
21 our founding fathers. When one uses his compensation to purchase a product, and sells it for a profit,
22 income is created. If it is grater then the allowed deductions, Income Tax must be paid.

1 Many of the current headaches, and unnecessary burdens, that taxpayers are facing today could be
2 removed if only the IRS would obey all Constitutional laws and properly define income. Simplifying
3 the filing process has helped many people. However, employers should not be required to withhold any
4 compensation from their employees, employees should retain control of their compensation and they
5 should decide their own course of action.

6 Over-time the IRS has tried to make us believe that our compensation falls under this category. In order
7 to promote this deception many rules and regulations were developed to cloud the issue. Constitutional
8 Laws are enforceable. Rules and regulations are used to clarify a law. They have no force of law. The
9 IRS is not a member of the US government and must stop trying to make people believe that it is part of
10 the US treasury. A law is unconstitutional if it is vague, or if it requires one to relinquish one
11 Constitutional right to obtain another. Our judiciary already has ample Laws to protect our voting
12 public, if they would only enforce them, and hold the IRS accountable.

13 The American people need to start paying more attention to what is happening. When a Judge or any
14 elected official steps out of line we must do whatever it takes to make them do their jobs. Evil can only
15 survive as long as good men do nothing. Justice and Freedom are not free. The price is vigilance and
16 action.
