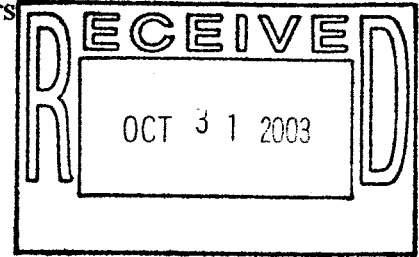

Dear Ms. Young:

On Friday, October 17, 2003, you attempted to intimidate Marian Merewitz and Cintia Cabib of MCT's Training Department. In a calm, civil manner, they requested that you comply with our rules for use of field equipment and attempted to explain those rules to you. You responded with aggressive, confrontational actions and verbal abuse.

This incident is the latest in a series of angry interactions with MCT staff. You have demonstrated repeatedly your unwillingness to comply with our long-established policies on the use of facilities and equipment. Your conduct has disrupted the normal operation of the facilities and has drained time and energy needed to assist other access users. To date, we have tried to accommodate your behavior and to bend the rules for you. However, that accommodation must end.

MCT's basic policy on eligibility to use our facilities states: "MCT may refuse access to eligible users who interfere with the orderly conduct of agency activities." The provision on user conduct states that one of the reasons for refusing access to our facilities is when a user "repeatedly violates policies and procedures established by MCT".

In the past, you have been unwilling to comply with our policies and procedures and to treat our staff with appropriate civility. Therefore, I am suspending your MCT membership for a period of three months. Effective today, you no longer have the privilege of using MCT facilities and equipment.

If you wish to be reinstated after the three-month suspension period, you must write to MCT's incoming Executive Director, Richard Turner, before January 10, 2004, stating that you will comply with MCT's policies and procedures and that you will not yell, threaten, or act in an aggressive manner towards the staff. Upon receipt of this letter, Mr. Turner will confirm that the suspension will be lifted on January 23. If we find thereafter a repetition of past unacceptable behavior, we will pursue the next step of permanent revocation of your access privileges.

You may appeal my decision by writing to the President of the Board of Directors, Nancy Poole, at the MCT office address above. Your letter must be received at MCT within two weeks of the date of this letter. The President will review your appeal with the Executive Committee of the Board and the Committee's decision will be final.

I regret that I must take this action. I hope you will understand my reasons.

SUBJECT: COMPLAINT- ACCUMULATIVE (never been properly resolved).
UNJUST PRACTICES: BROADCAST & DAILY LIFE
FRAUD-CRIME-INJUSTICE NETWORKS OPERATION

(I). These complaints are related to previous complaints with numerous issues, against MCT (training, etc.) and fraud- crime- injustice networks, including those dated 9/5/2003, 9/15/2003, and 9/29/2003 by fax or email. Some may be unjustly manipulated, influenced. Recent incidences are provided below.

(II). The problems are continuing, on-going with threat, coercion, victimization, retaliation, falsification, false excuses, as part of official misconduct- government gang-fraud- crime- injustice networks”, which cause serious socio-political problems; not just adversely victimized me, but also our society, peace and justice in vicious cycles.

(III). Related to those who supervise, conspire, cover-up unlawful acts, frauds, crimes, harassment, intimidation, unjust practices, stalking, surveillance, in charge of scheduling, airing, playback, editing, compiling programs; staff, volunteers, or impersonators.

(IV). RECENT EXAMPLES of problems, unjust practices, as parts of patterns and “fraud- crime- injustice networks” operation are provided below.

(A). General:

(1). MCT broadcast of my studio series “CITIZEN TIMES” has continued problems: unjustly manipulated, adversely impacted.

(2). Not broadcast my program “CITIZEN TIMES” fairly, causes confusion and frustration to audience; not broadcast at 4:00 pm according to “MCT Program Guide”; likely to air minutes AFTER 4:30 pm with varieties of abuses.

(3). Not broadcast my program (studio series of different episodes with different contents) as frequently as other programs, including class projects

(4). Frequently, MCT cut off my programs on either or both ends with varieties of abuses.

(B). Specific incidences. Date: 10/23/2003, Place MCT, broadcast, kitchen:

(1). The airing of my program “CITIZEN TIMES” was cut off suddenly both ends, as if incomplete sentence. NO TITLE, no end portion, no credit roll, etc.

(2) Some “GRAINS” and “SHAKES”, not supposed to.

(3) The TV was “off” by itself and appears “BLACK” several times, whether it was turn off remotely by some one, or built in MCT airing program should be examine.

(4) When I was watching TV, Bernard Dowell came and turned to other channel without my consent, as he did previously, very rude. I disagreed.

(5) A white female talked with Larry Merewitz very loud that I had to turn the volume up. Others, like Cintia Cabib came and go.

**COMPLAINT- ADDITIONAL:
UNJUST PRACTICES IN MCT BROADCAST**

(I). These are related to previous complaints, with numerous issues, including those in 9/5/2003 press release and those sent to MCT, including training departments, etc., and those sent on 9/15/2003 by fax or email. Some may be unjustly manipulated, influenced.

(II). Related to those who give direction or are in charge of scheduling, airing, playback, editing or compiling programs to be aired.

(III). Related to those people, staff or even volunteers who are in charge or perform the tasks with "MISCONDUCT" and "UNJUST PRACTICES, as those complained previously.

(IV). More importantly, these are related to "official misconduct- government gang- fraud- crime- injustice networks", which cause serious socio-political problems; not just adversely victimized me, but also our society, peace and justice in vicious cycles.

(V). The examples of recent problems, unjust practices, and part of patterns and "fraud- crime- injustice networks" operation are provided below:

(1). MCT broadcast of my studio series "CITIZEN TIMES" has continued to have problems. My program has been unjustly manipulated and adversely impacted.

(2). MCT has not broadcast my program "CITIZEN TIMES" fairly, and continue to have caused confusion and frustration to audience.

(3). MCT has not broadcast my program "CITIZEN TIMES" at 4:00 pm according to "MCT Program Guide".

(4). MCT has not broadcast my program "CITIZEN TIMES", studio series of different episodes with different contents as frequently as other programs, even class projects.

(5). Frequently, MCT cut off my programs on either or both ends with varieties of abuses.

(6). MCT does not even start broadcast of my program at 4:30 p.m. It started unnecessarily a few minutes AFTER 4:30 pm with varieties of abuses, as complained previously.

(7). On 9/25/2003, the airing of my program "CITIZEN TIMES" was manipulated in terrible manners and adverse impacts:

(A). The broadcast of my program "CITIZEN TIMES" was cut short; e.g., WITHOUT THE BEGINNING PORTION, including TITLE, HOST PAGE, and significant portion of INTRODUCTORY, and MUSIC, and cause the discontinuity of the MUSIC.

(B). MCT has unjustly used the "BLACK", "SNOW", or "GRAINY" to cut short or damage my program, and cause adverse impacts on my program and me.

COMPLAINED ISSUES – ADDITIONAL: Recent Incidence on 9/11/2003

(Related to previous complaints, with numerous issues, including those in 9/5/2003 press release and those previously sent to MCT, including training departments, etc. Some may be unjustly manipulated, influenced.)

(I). MCT broadcast of my studio programs "CITIZEN TIMES" continues to have problems:

- (1). My program did not start at 4:00 pm, and did not start at 4:30 p.m. It started a few minutes after 4:30 pm. This causes confusion and frustration to audience.
- (2). The aired program was cut short without end portion and without credit roll.
- (3). There were some shifts on the screen video images during the airing of my program, unlike what I produced, e.g., about the air time of 4:54-4:57 pm.

(II). Rude, unjust practices, discrimination, victimization, harassment, intimidation continue against me, or attempt to cover-up the problems e.g., those in (I) above.

- (1). I was interrupted to watch TV by MCT staff, especially Bernard Dowell, as he did previously.
- (2). Before and around 4:30 pm, When no one in the kitchen/eating area of the MCT, and no one was watching TV, except me. I turned TV to Montgomery Community Television Channel 19, sat down and watched TV.
- (3). Cintia Cabib came in and left.
- (4). Bernard Dowell came in and interrupted me to watch.
- (3). Bernard Dowell used remote control to change to other channel, e.g., channel 75, without my consent or even asked.
- (4). I opposed his behavior, but was disregarded.
- (5). I told him I was there first, but was still ignored.
- (6). I told him to change to Channel 19, but he would not.
- (7). Bernard Dowell did not really watch TV. He just change the channel and left with the remote control.
- (8). I turned the channel manually to Ch. 19 and watched again.
- (9). He came back to change the channel and left with remote control again.
- (10). He told other people that this lady (i.e., complainant) always gives him a lot of problems.

(III). (1) The problems stated in (I) and (II) above are related, and

(2). Related to those who give direction or are in charge of scheduling, airing, playback, editing or compiling programs to be aired.

(3). Bernard Dowell and others who direct others to commit misconduct, or are assigned to do those jobs and/or misconduct and unjust practices should be responsible

CALL TO ACTION

"FRAUD-CRIME NETWORKS" OPERATION IN MCT

This is to complain and request investigation on incidences related to "official misconduct- government gang- fraud- crime- injustice networks" operation in Montgomery Community Television (MCT). The investigation should be thorough and expeditious, and problems corrected immediately. Investigative report should be available to the complainant and the public.

1. The complaints below are in addition to, and related to my previous complaints pending investigation. And the issues are related to many sections of MCT, e.g., training, administration, broadcast, scheduling, facilities; field production or studio production, etc.

2. Related to "official misconduct- government gang- fraud- crime- injustice networks", which penetrate every segment of our lives, and should be incorporated with my other complaints/cases at administrative and judicial levels, as well as testimonies frequently made before government bodies, including Rockville City Mayor Council meetings (general and public hearings), Montgomery County Council public hearings, Maryland General Assembly sessions, law enforcement, agencies, commissions, and boards from local to federal levels:

- (A) Continuing, on-going,
- (B) Threats, coercion victimization, retaliation, discrimination, intimidation, deprivation, waste, abuse (law, power, authorities, resources), ineffectiveness, hostile environment.
- (C) Endless unlawful, immoral acts, frauds, crimes,
- (D) Unjust practices, schemes, manipulation, influence; falsification, rumors, misguidance, misleading, deceit, etc.
- (E) Obstruction, destruction, defamation, damages; resources, reputation, time; public and private sectors; civic, political, business; individuals, families, social relationships, affiliations, organizations, communities),
- (F) Causing serious socio-political problems; individuals, families, businesses, communities, society, peace, democracy, election process, fair market mechanism; civil/human rights backward; vicious circles.

3. Telecast CITIZEN TIMES studio series have been tampered, modified to be of inferior quality unlike what I produced. Similar problems did not appear in other programs or PSAs

before or after my programs "CITIZEN TIMES", and appears to be much worse than what occurred before; e. g., on Thursday, June 19, 2003, as shown on the MCT TV in the kitchen. It appears that the whole show "CITIZEN TIMES" had been tampered or modified to a great extent. The images of the telecast "CITIZEN TIMES" appear to be very dark/dim/dull/lack of contrast; and have several white bands across the images horizontally, especially in the middle.

4. The show "CITIZEN TIMES" were not scheduled to telecast as soon as possible, as other programs. E.g., the first episode of Citizen Times was produced on January 9, 2003, but was scheduled several months later that the telecast to begin on 4/24/2003.
5. The "CITIZEN TIMES" series are not telecast as frequently as other programs or episodes, e.g., field production were shown more often, probably 6-8 times during a short period of time.
6. Edit facilities (for both field and studio) appear to have problems frequently. It appears to be some bugging and irregularities. It not only makes the editing difficulty and time consuming, but also damage the materials, e.g., tapes, etc.
7. The programs produced by the complainant are mostly omitted in the MCT newsletters, and not publicized, like other programs by other persons.

RECENT FACTS - ADDITIONAL ALLEGATIONS (October - November 2002)

Complainant submitted a project proposal to have a video shoot starting November 14, 2002. Marian Merewitz (MCT) indicated a permit from National Park Services might be needed. Marian Merewitz failed to provide written regulation, laws, policies from MCT or National Park Services to support that, despite requests. When complainant inquired with other staff about the requirement, Merewitz said the project is fine, and no permit is needed. Later, Marian Merewitz fax me a concern about the permit again. Complainant contacted NPS, and found that NPS has no jurisdiction of individual activities, like described in complainant's proposal. Complainant wrote to MCT, and got a response from Cintia Cabib. Cabib basically retaliate against the complainant; denied my project, my opportunity to produce a broadcast program, my use of public access channel and facilities. Cintia Cabib not only ask complainant for NPS permit, but also basically asked complainant to start all over again for a new proposal. Thus it takes away complainant's time and resources. In the meantime, the "official misconduct- government gang- fraud- crime- injustice networks" continue to operate to victimize and retaliate against complainant and families. For more detail, see complainant's letters to MCT.

On November 8, 2002, complainant went to NPS to apply for a permit, just to satisfy MCT's arbitrary requirement, a conspiracy among "official misconduct- government gang- fraud- crime- injustice networks" against complainant. Complainant was not given a permit at that time, and was told the NPS staff will fax to the complainant. On November 12, 2002, Robbin Owen (NPS) call, left a phone message, but no mentioning the approval or disapproval, or want to fax complainant decision. When complainant called back, Robbin Owen basically indicates disapproval, and disconnected the line, or transferred the line to somewhere that no one answered even after many rings; repeated abuses and false excuses.

LIST OF APPEAL, COMPLAINT, REQUEST: (Part 2)

11/12/2003

Re: Montgomery Community Television (MCT)

(generally from complainant LIH YOUNG, unless otherwise indicated by *):



>> MCT personnel has changed a lot and shuffled unjustifiably to benefit or facilitate "fraud- crime network" operation; terminated or scared off good ones. Some instructors or staff were doing fine, but unable to stay or be promoted in MCT.

>> MCT staff in many ways work opposite to its missions; very destructive, lack of innovative, creative skills, cooperation; but full of unjust practices, schemes, manipulation, influences. It was very disappointed and discouraging to all.

>> MCT staff obstructs people (like me) from obtaining voter information and hinders democracy. E.g., on 10/23/2003, 5-6 pm, I was watching Rockville election and voter information on Cable Channel 11 in MCT kitchen, but the TV was remotely cut-off by someone, like numerous unjust practices to me and my studio show CITIZEN TIMES by Bernard Dowell and others. NOTE: Other unjust practices, as part of "fraud- crime-networks" have excluded me from candidate exposure; manipulated voters guides, tampered candidate information, and the webs (e.g., Rockville city, League of Women Voters' DNet, etc.), removed candidate photo, changed party affiliation, manipulated or concealed candidate statements, elections and issues, etc. No correction has been made, despite complaint.

>> 9/5/2003 **PRESS RELEASE** "complaint against: MCT and fraud- crime networks". Complained issues – general; additional and facts; incidence: MCT broadcast; incidences on 7/24/2003; incidences on 7/3/2003; problems in MCT facilities; on studio producer training; field training, etc.

>> 7/2/2003, "Comment or Evaluation on MCT training: studio Directors/ technicians".

>> 11/5/2002, Complainant request for a field production "PEACE, FREEDOM". The project was unjustly manipulated and disapproved. Sent to MCT training Marian Merewitz.

>> 10/18/2002 about 12:40 pm, Marian Merewitz denied a field production consultation, with unjust reason of unpaid due. I disagreed. I paid t when I signed up for the class. Marian Merewitz refused to check MCT internally, or checked with Francis Barrios whose desk was next to Marian. Eventually Marian transferred the call to Barrios who told me I was fine. Barrios agreed to talk to Marian, upon my request. Marian postponed the appointment for project consultation.

>> 7/20/2002 Request: evaluation of classes, information on certified volunteers. Sent to MCT training Matthew Kraft. MCT has failed to provide information, and violated MCT policies. The studio supervisory director was new, subject to others' unjust manipulation at MCT.

>> 4/18/2002 Repeated request: placing my project CITIZEN TIMES in the studio labs, and information on classes. Sent to MCT training department Cintia Cabib.

>> 4/18/2002 Re: airing quality, noise, etc., during the broadcast of my program "FEDERAL SHAMBLES: Civic Forum 2", as aired on 3/17/2002.

>> MCT has refused to provide information on volunteers and other requests; postponed to schedule a studio shoot. Besides, those from the list that MCT eventually provided did not show up for the studio work without even letting me know in advance.

Although the producer, host, anchorman, other volunteers and staff were present early, the studio work was totally cancelled by the MCT without doing any work. My suggestions to make at least some roll-in on the anchorman, etc., were denied by MCT.

>> 2/12/2002 Request information, studio projects, studio labs, roll-in, PSA, etc. Sent to MCT training Cintia Cabib.

>> 2/11/2002 Request to place my project CITIZEN TIMES in the studio lab. It is possible to do it immediately. If not, do it in the immediate future. Sent to MCT training Cintia Cabib. MCT still has disregarded the requests, even nearly two years later.

>> 2/11/2002 Request for information, on class, criteria, registration, certification, etc. MCT did not provide information, and violated MCT policies. Sent to MCT training Cintia Cabib.

*>> 2/7/2002, a letter from MCT training Cintia Cabib with false, misleading statements: (See more comments below.)

(1). In response to my request: "To allow "CITIZEN TIMES" to be made, videotaped and completed by studio classes".

Cintia responded: "There is currently no room available for "CITIZEN TIMES" to be produced as a studio lab.

(2). In response to my request: "...registration for the class... MCT staff informed me that all I need is some make-up and would not have to pay". (See also 12/22/2001 letter from MCT.)

Cintia responded: "You currently need to be certified in two areas audio and technical director... Since you miss the required labs.... We are looking to see if there are any supervised studio productions scheduled where you could be tested."

COMMENTS: The truth: MCT unequal treatment deprive of my time, resources. I still had to pay the EXTRA whole fee. MCT: irresponsibility, unjust schemes, manipulation, influences, victimization, retaliation; did not keep its promise. Even now nearly two years later, there still seems to be no hope on my requests. Instead, I was retaliated by serious adverse actions.

I attended the class and intended to use the technical director lab. But I was not assigned to do so (or unjustly manipulated from doing it). Actually, in a later class, the instructor stated that certain people were not assigned to certain labs, because prior performance had surpassed the satisfactory level and no need for further labs or tests. On audio lab, I did not miss it either, and I did not agree that my performance was worse than others who have passed. NOTE: The TA for the audio lab was Larry Merewitz (Marian Merewitz's husband, both worked in MCT). Larry had not mentioned to me that I did poorly in class or audio lab. In fact, he was surprised I took the class again. Besides, Larry Merewitz usually skipped teaching, or responding to my questions whether in class or labs. As evidenced in other occasions, Larry Merewitz seemed to be unjustly influenced and placed me in disadvantaged, humiliated, and hostile situations. See my other complaints and comments.

>> 2/5/2002 Additional complaints, requests; general questions, unjust practices. Sent to MCT training department, Cintia Cabib, Marian Merewitz, Matthew Kraft, Frances Barrios.

>> 2/5/2002 repeated request regarding class registration, fee, etc. NOTE: MCT staff informed the complainant just to make up, would not have to pay any more fee. I

was not given all labs that I had intended to participate in previous studio technician class. Sent to MCT training Cintia Cabib, Matthew Kraft, Frances Barrios.

>> 2/3/2002 COMPLAINTS, REQUESTS (related to complaints, requests, 1/27/2002, 1/28/2002). Sent to MCT training department, Cintia Cabib, Marian Merewitz, Matthew Kraft.

>> 1/28/2002 Request, suggestion, urge to act positively, creatively. Sent to MCT training department, Cintia Cabib, Marian Merewitz, Matthew Kraft.

>> 1/27/2002 Request, to place my project CITIZEN TIMES to be in labs series, like "501 C(3)", "Dance de Jour"; more frequent basis, better volunteer coordination, volunteer information. Sent to MCT training Matthew Kraft.

>> 12/22/2001, Letter regarding the fee for an upcoming training. Sent to MCT training Frances Barrios. I had been told not to pay, because I had not been given the opportunities for all labs in a previous class. (I attended the class, but was unable to have access to the labs.) Eventually I was asked to pay the WHOLE fee again. See other comments, e.g., 2/7/2002.

>> 12/15/2001 Requests, urge to act positively on requests, to remove dilemma/hurdle. Sent to MCT training Cintia Cabib, Marian Merewitz, Matthew Kraft (new, subject to unjust manipulation).

>> 12/14/2001 Repeated request, volunteer information. Sent to MCT training, Matthew Kraft (new, subject to unjust manipulation).

>> 12/05/2001, subject: "Copy of program for airing and competition; Federal Shambles: Civic Forum 1", regarding the problems in airing my production. Sent to MCT Training Department, Cintia Cabib, Marian Merewitz, Francis Barrios.

>> 11/14/2001, Re: "copy of program for airing and competition", concerning the inferior quality that MCT has made in airing my production "Twilight of Judiciaries (III), e.g., aired on 11/8/2001. Sent to MCT training, Cintia Cabib, Marian Merewitz, Frances Barrios.

>> 10/22/2001, subject: "the program I produced... hands on News, "program Pipeline", regarding the unequal treatment on promotion, scheduling the air time, etc. Sent to MCT training, Cintia Cabib, Marian Merewitz, Frances Barrios.

>> 10/03/2001, Letter subject: Award competition, complaint: unequal treatment; unjust obstruction, manipulation or influences by "official misconduct- government gang-fraud- crime- injustice networks". Sent to MCT Training Department, Cintia Cabib, Marian Merewitz, Frances Barrios.

CALL TO ACTION, INVESTIGATION

COMPLAINT AGAINST: MCT AND FRAUD-CRIME NETWORKS.

COMPLAINED ISSUES – GENERAL

(Some may be unjustly manipulated, influenced. Additional issues/ facts are provided.)

(1). These complaints are to be incorporated with previous complaints, comments on training; correspondences and testimonies. My major concerns are related to “official misconduct- government gang- fraud- crime- injustice networks”, which penetrate every segment of our lives:

- (A) Continuing, on-going,
- (B) Threats, coercion victimization, retaliation, discrimination, intimidation, deprivation, waste, abuse (law, power, authorities, resources), ineffectiveness; create undesirable environment which are hostile, uncomfortable, and dangerous).
- (C) Endless unlawful, immoral acts, frauds, crimes,
- (D) Unjust practices, patterns; schemes, manipulation, influence; falsification, rumors, misguidance, misleading, deceit, etc.
- (E) Obstruction, destruction, defamation, damages; resources, reputation, time; progress, productivity, achievement, capability; public and private sectors; civic, political, business; individuals, families, social relationships, affiliations, organizations, communities),
- (F) Causing serious socio- economic- political problems; individuals, families, businesses, communities, society, peace, democracy, election process, fair market mechanism; civil/human rights backward; vicious cycles.

(2). ON MCT broadcast of POLITICAL CANDIDATE’S STATEMENT: MCT used to include Write-in candidates when I first run for public office in 1994. But when I continue to run for various offices both primary and general elections, MCT discontinued the “Write-in”, despite my objection. Thus under unjust practices, manipulation and influences, MCT become more anti-democratic, anti-progressive.

(3). My car was vandalized in the MCT rear parking lot. The rear mirror was removed twice. The similar experience was by "fraud- crime networks", including insurance company, car repair and law enforcement.

(4). MCT broadcast of my programs are in less time and frequency, compared with others', including training class project. My program was cut short tremendously; delayed even in the scheduling of broadcast for several months, and further delayed in actual broadcast.

(5). My studio series "CITIZEN TIMES" have continually been censored, tampered, adversely modified, or cut short significantly to be inferior or less desirable than what I produced.

(A). Abuse, misuse, overuse or redundant use of commercials PSAs to cut off my program on both ends.

(B). MCT improperly increase varieties of noises, disturbances, or sound volumes; even with sound like friction or ocean wave during host talk.

(6). Edit facilities continue to have serious problems or being bugged frequently; make editing more difficult and time consuming; obstruct progress and productivity; or even damage tapes or products, etc.

(7). Serious problems and disturbances occurred most of the time, when my program 'CITIZEN TIMES". Such problems did not appear in other programs or commercial PSAs, especially those aired before or after "CITIZEN TIMES".

(8). MCT employee (e.g. Bernard? who told me he lives at MCT), disallowed me to watch TV as he did previously.

(9). Practically, the "fraud-crime networks tried to rob my account, and obstruct my activities to deprive my resources, reputation and account balance, to have my check bounced with further penalty, etc. Other checks that I issued later were cashed without problems. After that, there was still a lot of balance in the account.

(10). MCT staff, e.g., Cintia Cabib, Marian Merewitz, etc., stalked and surveillanced against me; obstruct my activities; would not provide help or resolve problems quickly, whether on facilities, scheduling or broadcast.

(11). People are misinformed, unjustly manipulated or influenced with false reasons; to obstruct or damage my projects; to do wrong and would not show up, as in my first attempt to produce a studio show.

(12). Unjust rumors, falsification, defamation, damages (reputation, capability, resources, time); create hostile environment, dangerous situations.

(13). The training deviate greatly from course description; complainant was harassed to drop the course; unjust denial to participate in the labs; harassed to pay fees again, despite waiver of fees was indicated because of denial of opportunities, equipment and labs; Unjust influence in grading and performance evaluation. According to instructor in later classes that no further labs or tests were necessary, when the prior work had been adequately satisfactory.

(14). Other problems: Teaching assistants (e.g. Larry Merewith and Marian Merewith, a co-producer Cathy Fiske(?)) unfair treatment and evaluation against me; as in several circumstances; disregarded my questions, inquiries; inconsistency between the text materials and the equipment as in audio, etc

COMPLAINED ISSUES – ADDITIONAL, AND FACTS:

(I). INCIDENCE: MCT broadcast:

(1). On 8/28/2003 the problems occurred in nearly two-third of the aired time when my studio program "CITIZEN TIMES" was aired; i.e., about 20 minutes (4:37-4:56 pm) out of about 30 minutes of air time; with white bands and flushes across horizontally in the middle of the TV screen, and grainy snows type of disturbances spread on the whole screen for a lengthy air time (4:44 pm – 4:56 pm). The grainy snows looked like an extra layer of input over the product that I had produced.

(2). According to MCT broadcast program guide, Thursday 4:00- 5:00 pm (one hour) is for "CITIZEN TIMES" (my studio series), but MCT does not do accordingly. The air time was cut in half or more. The unjust practices and misinformation is not only against me but also the general public.

(3). MCT broadcast of "CITIZEN TIMES" varies in time and problems: e. g.: On 8/21/2003, the program was cut short on both ends; NO title, and NO end portion. Instead of starting at 4:00 pm according to program guide, it started a few minutes AFTER 4:30 pm. Other serious occurred: e.g., (A). Abuse, misuse, overuse or redundant use of commercials PSAs to cut off my program on both ends; (B).MCT improperly increase varieties of noises, disturbances, or sound volumes even with sound like friction or ocean wave during host talk; (C). Problems did not appear in other programs on TV aired before or after the "CITIZEN TIMES.

(4). Incidences on 7/31/2003: (A). About 3:30 pm.(Note: not 4:30 pm), MCT employee (Bernard?) He saw me when he was talking to other people in MCT rear parking lot. He immediately went to the MCT kitchen/ eating area and sat down to watch TV. I sat there too. Then he left. I turned to Channel 19 (Montgomery Community Television). But he came back to change to other Channel without my consent, or even asked me. (B). After repeated like these, he called me "YOU ARE A CRAZY LADY!".

(II). INDICENCES ON 7/24/2003:

(1). MCT employee (Bernard?) in bad mood, harassed and obstructed me to watch TV in the kitchen/ eating area of MCT, as he did previously. Around 4:30 pm, when nobody was watching TV, I went to turn the TV on Channel 19 (Montgomery Community Television), but he immediately changed to other Channels without my consent or even asked. I was harassed and obstructed. He said he wanted to watch TV while eating dinner, but was not really watching. I asked just to see a few minutes, or even just a few seconds to see what was on Channel 19, he still would not allow me to. Eventually he left after 4:40 pm without finishing watching the program that he turned on.

(2). My program "Citizen Times" on Channel 19 had been tampered, and cut short tremendously, probably on both ends. The program ends at 4:50 pm., not near 5:00 pm as supposed to.

(III). INCIDENCES ON 7/3/2003: I discovered that the coffee table for my studio show was scratched with sharp tools..

(IV). PROBLEMS in MCT FACILITIES:

(1). Equipment and facilities have problems or being bugged quite frequently, mysteriously.

(2). My work, activities or tapes have been obstructed and damaged. The problems occurred quite often. Someone must have abused, misused, damaged or bugged the edit facilities.

(3). 8/19/2003, about 8:00 pm – 9:30 pm.; (A). Audio sound seemed to be cut into pieces; first source player, then master player; (B) Source deck player would not function, rewind, eject, etc. (C). Some band of grains and flushes horizontally across the central portion of the monitor screen; (D). It appeared that a translucent black layer was input over the videotape images; and made the videos look very undesirable, dark, dim and unclear; (4). Mysterious and unexpected input of “Black” by someone may seriously affect, black out, or erase the video contents, if not very careful.

(4). After full of frustration in one edit booth, I asked to change to a different booth, but was told all occupied. Strangely, one booth was open with no light on; nobody in it. Facilities staff then said I could use it, just to find that some parts of the equipment were missing, e.g. parts of the slots for tapes. Facilities staff immediately inquired the person who just used it, and found that person took the parts out without facilities approval of the facilities staff. Because of such problems, I could not use the facilities, and my projects were obstructed.

(V). ON STUDIO PRODUCER TRAINING:

(1). In one of the producer training: (A). Someone tried to obstruct our project, despite everything went smoothly to produce a segment on law enforcement in studio program “The Spot”, in which I agreed to take major responsibilities to design, contact hosts/guests, prepare script, etc. (B). Paul Amon and others suddenly wanted to change EVERYTHING with FALSE REASONS that the hosts/guests would not come. I was surprised and disagreed. Fortunately, the project moved on, and the hosts/guests did show up for studio work as planned; (C). The script of the program was changed without my prior knowledge until the studio production time. I corrected it. (D). Instructors Francine Wyon warned participants not to cause false alarm, because she was told about a false fire alarm at MCT. I indicated that the false alarm itself might be false, and the false alarm might also be caused by those related to “official misconduct- government gang- fraud- crime- injustice networks” at the expense of others. e.g., My call to police was transferred to fire department by police in bad-faith. (E). Francine Wyon was suddenly changed to another position and discontinued her teaching. This was unusual, considering she was doing fine, and her new job was in the local area. (F). Unnecessary change of instructor affect the class, lab, equipment; easier for someone to unjustly manipulate and influence others, even if new instructor is good. (See my comments or evaluation on training.)

(2). Also in studio training: (A). During studio set-up, Larry Merewitz said there was rumors against me, but would not be more specific. (B). Unjust practices, manipulation, influences: irregular, inconsistent, discriminatory and improper orders or maneuver by someone, staff, teaching assistants, etc.; on or in the use of equipment or labs. (C). Skipped or lack of instruction, ignored or disregarded questions or inquiries. (D). Secret arrangement without open discussion while under unjust practices led to adverse effects, humiliation; e.g., in mock play, teleprompter, equipment, script, material,

etc. (E). The equipment and its parts, e.g., teleprompter and its lens might be changed to someone's disadvantage.

(3). In studio training, teaching assistant Marian Merewitz improperly, unjustly manipulated, humiliated, and victimized me by abuse of her power, perhaps with influence of others, as in field projects. She wanted me to stand in a bad corner where I could not function well as a Floor Director. She would not listen or discuss and went away. When she came back, she just yelled, "O. K. You want to do your way, fine," but would not want to listen to me or discuss, except to claim her authority. She even violated MCT rule by stepped on the cable so that I could not walk around with it, as I needed to. By stepping on the cable, Marian violated the MCT rule. Someone helped me to remove her feet away from the cable. My reputation, social relation and performance record were degraded to a great extent. People are usually misled and unjustly influenced.

(4). A co-producer Cathy Fiske (? white female) often in hostile manner said she would handle the water to the guests, rather than me. She did not give me any feedback. Instead, words spread around that I did not perform well, did not work well with producer or hosts, thus hurt my reputation, social relation and performance record.

(VI). IN FIELD TRAINING (around April – July 2001):

(1). Falsehood, hostile and dangerous situations: (A). A mysteriously strange person Ashley Block (white female) joined field producer class, but would not give contact information (address, phone, email, etc.). I was assigned to work with her and Edna Rangolan (black, female, technician training) as a team. (B). Unjust schemes, defamation; ignored my suggestions; cancelled agreements or meeting without notifying me. E.g., A meeting was scheduled after the class, but no other team members shown up, thus left me in the dark late in the evening about 11 PM. Arbitrary changes in work sites, guests, without information. Ashley Block did not do her part in training, and blamed on me. I helped her, and offered various suggestions, but were not appreciated. Ashley provided false statements to instructor and others. She even yelled and screamed, and pretended as if I hurt her so much.

(2). A teaching assistant tried to help Ashley transport the equipment to the work site that Ashley had just decided. We followed Ashley's car (with Edna Rangolan) and wound up going around the streets, even opposite direction to the work site. The field work was rescheduled to a different date later to be done at MCT.

(3). MCT did not allow me to do my field projects (different projects) at MCT.

(4). In editing: (A). I was unjustly blamed and harassed. (B). Ashley did not do her part as required, ignored my suggestions, and could not or would not have the job progressed properly. (C). Larry Merewitz (MCT, spouse of Marian Merewitz), not an assigned TA at the time) appeared to blame on me. (D) The work was finished, despite difficulty, but was not telecast. Cintia Cabib (Head of Training Division) said that was Ashley's decision.

###

COMMENT OR EVALUATION ON MCT TRAINING: Studio Directors/Technicians

- (1). Redesign the class to reflect the full description of the course as announced to the public, i.e., 6 weeks of instruction, and 6 weeks of labs. More weights should be given on the tests given after the course is over, or at the end of the class, not the beginning,
- (2). All participants should have full rights and equal opportunities in access to instruction, equipments and labs.
- (3). More general instruction and open discussion should be made, not just small groups by TA, to avoid unjust, inconsistent, and incorrect manipulation, or even without instruction, and thus cause adverse impact on certain persons.
- (4). More open discussion should be made among all, including those in the control room and the studio. Instructor and those in control room may not be aware of the real cause of problems, and vice versa.
- (5). Avoid arbitrary, unjust manipulation and influences, which cause adverse impacts on some, including operation of equipment, progress, achievement and reputation. Some may seem small and just like joke, but can be very serious, from discrimination, unjust practices, unlawful acts to serious damages.
- (6). Avoid secret instruction or assignment, mock play, especially without open discussion among the whole class, which can cause false impression and adverse impacts on some
- (7). Avoid arbitrary, inconsistent and incorrect instruction or secret manipulation, bugging, obstruction, which target and cause adverse impact, e.g., obstruction and damages against certain persons on, e.g.:
 - . Teleprompter, camera, equipment itself, including lens change.
 - . the use and operation of the equipment, their positions, etc.
 - . edit facilities
 - . bugging in edit facilities, some may even as remote as outside the facilities.
- (8). Text book or reading materials should be updated, and consistent with current equipment, e.g., reading materials on p. 59-62 and p. 69.
- (9). More explanation, analysis, and show how it works, rather than just push this button and that, this color or that, especially when they are inconsistent with reading materials.
- (10). More open and analytical discussion, rather than just assign particular position, despite concerned issues had presented. This is especially serious because of unjust, secret manipulation by TA and others, whom may be arrogant to have power and authorities but could not discuss or interact fairly.

Later, you said it is fine, no permit necessary, when I inquired other MCT staff about the requirement and written regulation, and would like to have a copy of those regulations or requirements.

Your fax (received 11/4/2002, dated 10/31/2002) does not mention if my project is approved or disapproved. Your fax does not reflect a true written regulation on individuals' camera shoot in the National Park Services areas in DC, as in my case.

Immediately (11/4/2002), I called several times with the phone number you gave me (202-619-7184) for National Park Service, a male answered the phone, but disconnected the lines, without proper response or even without any response and hung up.

I called a different phone number for National Park Service (202-619-7222). A female answered the phone. She told me that camera shoot like my case does not need permits.

I called you right away (11/4/2002) and left a message - my report back to you about my inquiry with National Park Service and my request for your EXPLICIT approval of the project.

I have not received your call to confirm explicitly the approval of the project since then. I am looking forward to your quick response.

I am writing in response to the letters we have received from you.

First, please note that in order to produce a studio show you need nine volunteers to fill the necessary positions. On the day you were scheduled to videotape your studio production, you had scheduled four people and only two volunteers came. Since there were not enough volunteers for your production, it was cancelled. I understand that you were disappointed, but as you know, studio productions require several crew members. In order to have a successful studio production the next time, please schedule and confirm enough crew members in advance. Staff members are here to supervise productions, not to act as crew members.

Studio Instructor Matthew Kraft has met with you several times to discuss your program proposal, script and set design. He has reserved studio time for your production, composed the character generator information for you, transferred music onto a compact disc, provided you with names and contact information of certified crew members for your production, and set up the studio set for you on the date of your studio taping. It is now your responsibility to schedule crew members for your next taping.

I would like reply to your specific requests:

Request: "MCT to coordinate responsible, reliable volunteers for the project. MCT to supply complete, reliable, and workable lists of volunteers and the types of job that volunteers would like to do."

- MCT has provided you with names of certified studio technicians and directors. It is your responsibility to inquire about their availability, whether they have a preference regarding a specific crew position, and schedule them for your taping.

Request: "To allow 'Citizen Times' to be made on more frequent basis."

- You must first complete and submit one completed studio program. After this has been done, another studio taping date can be scheduled.

Request: "MCT studio slots or available schedules for studio shoots."

- Matt has provided you with studio availability dates.

Request: "Can I work on a studio project and a field project at the same time or overlapping in time?"

- You may work on **one** field production while working on a studio production.

Request: "To allow 'Citizen Times' to be made, videotaped and completed by studio classes."

- There is currently no room available for "Citizen Times" to be produced as a studio lab.

Request: "In response to my previous letter regarding the registration for the class, MCT staff informed me that all I need is some make-up and would not have to pay."

- You currently need to be certified in two areas of studio technician: audio and technical director. As you know, attendance at all labs is mandatory in order for a student to become certified. Since you missed the required labs, the only way to make them up is to be trained and tested by a staff person on an actual studio production. We are looking to see if there are any supervised studio productions scheduled where you could be tested.

MCT's policies and procedures are in place in order to make sure that the facilities are used efficiently and that productions run smoothly. The employees have worked diligently to assist you with your studio production. It is expected that you, in turn, will fulfill your responsibilities as a producer and will work cooperatively with MCT staff members.

- (2). MCT should be **FREE FROM UNJUST PRACTICES, POLICIES, MANIPULATION, INFLUENCES BY "FRAUD- CRIME- INJUSTICE NETWORKS"** directly and indirectly, which obstruct people's work, project, participation, and reputation like mine. There has been many incidences of unjust practices that adversely affect me, in many aspects. MCT should not allow them to continue working in wrong direction and unjust destruction. Your thorough investigation on unjust practices and obstruction, etc., would be greatly appreciated.
- (3): I do not agree with MCT staff Matt Kraft's BRIEF response (e-mail 2/4/2002). Matt Kraft is new at MCT. It appears that he has been seriously misguided and unjustly influenced by others, including class/lab assignment and the working on the project; arbitrary list of technicians/directors. unjust practices, discrimination, or horror, etc, to facilitate/benefit wrongdoers and against some people.

(5). To what extent a MCT certified person (like me, as a producer on both studio and field, plus field technician) can (A) exercise his/her independent decision/judgment without arbitrary refusal/denial/obstruct by others; (B) use available facilities, studio, field or combinations; and (C) to obtain assistance from the staff as quickly as possible, studio, field or combination?

This is to URGE MCT to act POSITIVELY and CREATIVELY on requests/ suggestions, to work effectively utilizing resources on existing conditions, to remove any dilemma/ hurdle/obstruct, and to allow projects to progress in reasonable and flexible ways.

On 1/26/2002, a couple of technical director/technician (Jordan Hollander and Mario Godoy) were absent. But there were other technicians and staff there. Instead of canceling the whole thing without doing any work, my request was to videotape at least the anchor to be later used as a roll-in., but Matt denied such request. The anchor's statements altogether are just a few minutes, and not the main portion of the project. Actually, anchor and host can be taped independently and edited later with other portions, e.g., music, etc., which are handily available, under unexpected circumstances.

To videotape anchor is a simple task, with no need of technical director. This will save another trip of that anchor and the reputation of our capability. This is a result-oriented project. We want the result, not a restrictive assignment, especially not let any obstruction/ hurdle to prevent us from accomplishing our goals.

The anchor has been very cooperative. He was there in the studio very early in the morning, and had been waiting for his taping. He and other technicians were very disappointed, and so was I.

The factors out of my control have affected my plans and products; not somebody else, e.g., absent technician/director. As a producer, I have designed the plan, not the absent technician/director. Whenever problems occur, I present solutions to fix, rather than being stalled by obstruction in every possible ways.

Last minute withdrawal prohibits the progress of the project, and waste other participants' time, especially without any notice or justifiable reasons.

*** As you are aware of, the volunteer lists are not categorized by type of job (e.g., CG, VTR, audio) that volunteers would or able do the best, unlike what you told me in the earlier stage of the project.





I had submitted seven (7) applications for competition by the deadline:

4. "Twilight of Judiciaries (III) People's Voice and Protest!"
5. "Law Enforcement" in the Program "The Spot."
6. "Federal Shambles: Civic Forum1"
7. "Federal Shambles: Civic Forum 2"

Each of these programs should be treated as an independent entry. Each has full content, about one hour or longer, except class projects (Items 1 and 5).

Each has a different title, format, setting, content, and speakers. Some programs or books are different, although entitled the same or similar. e.g., those entitled "George Washington" or "Washington, D.C."; or some other movies and sequels.

None of my programs above is a part of "a routine series" broadcast by MCT on any routine basis; e.g., weekly or monthly, as you might think.

MCT did not telecast and has not even scheduled to telecast my program "Twilight of Judiciaries (III) People's Voice and Protest!", despite submitted on 6/20/2001, about 3-1/2 months ago..

The other two programs submitted on the same day 6/20/2001 were only aired twice each. These programs were not aired as a series by MCT. "Twilight of Judiciaries (I) Donna

Briggs: Uncommon Lawyer” was aired twice, and “Twilight of Judiciaries (II) Civic Forum” was aired twice later; with quite a lengthy time span.

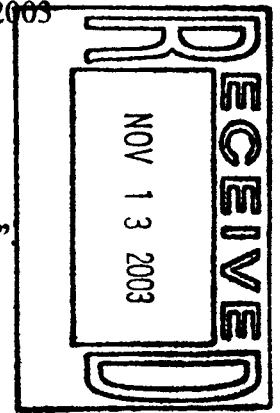
My programs have not received equal treatment, frequency or opportunity for telecast as other programs which were produced or completed later than mine.

Previously, the reason for unequal treatment or no telecast scheduling or air time for my programs was because all scheduling would be done in the following fiscal year, as given to me by Marian and Cintia, upon my repeated inquiries. It is clear that such reason is false and unjustified.

I believe there have been some serious wrongdoings, unjust obstruction, manipulation and influence on my activities, production, and telecast scheduling of my programs at MCT by “official misconduct- government gang- fraud- crime- injustice networks”, as I complained. I strongly urge MCT for an investigation. I strongly hope MCT staff or volunteers, not to be unjustly manipulated or influenced by “official misconduct- government gang- fraud- crime- injustice networks,” which penetrate every segment of our lives; impact adversely on productivity; and destroy individuals, families, businesses, society, justice and peace.

ALLEGATION – COMPLAINED ISSUES:

>> MCT staff, including those complained above, worked opposite government function, violated MCT mission policies, rules, regulations; have censored, tampered, obstructed, adversely impacted my projects, programs, telecast, airing, promotion, scheduling, ..., etc.; unequal treatment, discrimination, victimization, harassment, retaliation, falsification, false statements, unjust practices, schemes, manipulation, influences; ...disregarded complained issues, management responsibilities, etc. See also other complaints and supporting documents.

>> John A. Hansman has simply rushed to abuse the power, unjust practices, unlawful acts; victimized, retaliated against complainant, because numerous complained issues has been filed in recent years, including MCT recent unjust practices, unlawful acts, distortion of media, and conspiracies related to "fraud-crime-injustice networks" operation, identity theft, stealing customer's financial accounts, employment/retirement/social program benefits; caused bouncing check and penalty fee, deprived/ damaged complainant or customer's resources, reputation, etc. See also my other complaints, especially press release 9/5/2003.

>> 10/23/2003 (postmark 10/22/2003) John A. Hansman has been rushing to misuse/abuse the "Interim Executive Director"; unjustly issue his decision letter against me, and bypass the authority of the EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR. The new Executive Director has been appointed effective October 15, 2003.

>> John A. Hansman's 10/23/2003 decision letter was mainly to punish and retaliate against complainant; silenced the complainant; deprived complainant's rights, privileges of MCT membership; deprive the use of MCT facilities; obstruct activities, progress, achievement; isolate the complainant from others; damage social relationship, destroy fair media, democratic, political, election processes, market mechanism, destroy communities, peace, ..., and more, as related to "official misconduct- government gang- fraud- crime- injustice networks."

>> John Hansman's 10/23/2003 has been the only correspondence he has ever sent me in all these years, despite my numerous complaints sent to Executive Director, Hohn Hansman he himself, Board of Director, other MCT staff, etc.; never discussed,

talked, inquired about the concerned problems that I raised. He has been not only irresponsible but also involved in unjust, practices, manipulation, stalking, surveillance, unlawful acts, crimes, against me; never addressed the complained issues; not even mentioned any of my complained issue in his decision letter.

>> In his decision letter of 10/23/2003, he has basically LIED a lot; not only used RHETORICALLY false statements, false excuses; unjust reasons, but also abused authority with extremely harsh unreasonable adverse actions against complainant.

>> John Hansman's decision of 10/23/2003: not a letter of warning, or even reprimand, or some minor adverse action, as usually done to some improper conduct, if it is true. But these are not the case.

>> John Hansman's decision of 10/23/2003: unequal treatment, unjust manipulation of the use of "suspension for three months", which under his manipulation as stated in his decision is equivalent to FOREVER. i.e., terminate forever all privileges, and never been treated equally as a citizen again. Usually, after suspension, the right and original status will be reinstated automatically, but not in Hansman's scheme. After three months, complainant has to start all over again to reapply for everything, with special clauses and conditions.

>> He has basically disregarded the basic causes of problems, and deprived of my right and equal treatment, fair media exposure, etc.; disapproved my field project "HONORING MLK LEGACY", use of equipment, facilities, or even access to MCT building – a public building.

>> John Hansman's decision did not tell the truth, except full of lies, unjust practices, manipulation. It is John Hansman, and MCT staff, and related "fraud- crime- injustice networks" has not followed the rules, regulations, MCT policies, as has been evidenced, documented and complained.

>> Unlike what are stated in John Hansman's decision letter, I have complied with all the rules and requirement. Certainly not "repeatedly violates policies and procedures established by MCT" as stated in John Hansman's letter. I understand the rules, policies.

>> I have produced some programs which have been telecast. My programs have been damaged when airing as by MCT related "fraud- crime- networks", as complained.

>> Contrary is true, the problems are with MCT and related "fraud- crime- injustice networks". I have disagreed with MCT staff and their endless unjust practices, manipulation and conspiracies, and disapproved my projects, damaged my projects, progress, products; destroy our society, democracy and peace, etc.

>> The incidence John Hansman cited was Friday October 17, 2003. John Hansman was not even at the scene or nearby; actually he was absent from MCT.

>> In John Hansman's decision, there was no mentioning of who say what; no affidavits or witnesses' statements provided.

>> MCT staff on Friday 10/17/ 2003 has continued unjust practices, manipulation, and practically disapproved my field project "HONORING MLK LEGACY", as they disapprove my other project "PEACE, FREEDOM". The field shoot for "Honoring MLK Legacy" was scheduled on October 25-26, 2003. Time is of essence. I wanted to see Cintia Cabib's supervisor, but Cintia cabib told me that I could not.

>> Then I was told the only person that I could contact was John Hansman. I wanted to see John Hansman immediately, but he was absent from MCT. I called John

Hansman through MCT phone immediately, but he was not available. I left a message urging his immediate approval of the field project "HONORING MLK LEGACY", and actions against Cintia Cabib and Marian Merewitz, etc. John Hansman has NOT returned my call, as usual.

>> John Hansman's decision letter of 10/23/2003: Tyrannically absurd, extremely arrogant. He has stated: "I am suspending your MCT membership for a period of three months. Effective today, you no longer have the privilege of using MCT facilities and equipment". There is no discussion, inquiries, investigation, feedback, proposal for adverse action, effective some future date, etc., as usually handled in normal management procedures.

>> Further, under his UNJUST SCHEME OF PERMANENT SUSPENSION OR TERMINATION, rather than automatic reinstatement to previous status, John Hansman has stated in his decision of 10/23/2003: "If you wish to be reinstated after the three-month suspension period, you must write to MCT....stating that you will comply with MCT's policies and procedures, and that you will not yell, threaten, or act in an aggressive manners towards the staff."

>> John Hansman's has also stated "upon receipt of, will confirm that the suspension will be lifted on January 23."

>> Then John Hansman stated a appeal to his own desire, bypassing EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, to President of the Board of Directors, Nancy Poole.

>> Although not explicitly stated in the John Hansman's letter, MCT staff has been coached, instructed, conspired to prohibit complainant from entering MCT, or access to building, or watch TV in MCT. Other MCT purposes for such drastic unreasonable schemes: (1) to prohibit me from watching telecast programs by MCT etc, (2) prohibit complaining about problems related to MCT, including airing of my programs, as I have complained; (3) drastic changes in MCT personnel; unequal opportunities; (4) prohibit fair investigation of the problems, complaints; (5) thus to benefit/facilitate "fraud- crime- injustice network" operation; (6) cause socio-political problems in vicious cycles.

>> 10/23/2003 Subject "Honoring MMLK Legacy, field production", regarding the unjust scheme and postponement to proceed the project. MCT unjust schemes, destruction, obstruction and damages by MCT, are very serious. Urge to confirm approval or disapproval, because the field shoot would be October 25-26, 2003, but MCT did not do so. Sent to MCT John Hansman, Cintia Cabib, Marian Merewitz.

>> 10/21/2003 Subject "Honoring MLK Legacy, field production", sending in a permit from the National Park Services, although it should not be required. After all, MCT does not have the rule or regulation on it, despite repeated requests.

>> My request for field project "Honoring MLK Legacy" was practically not approved by MCT Cintia Cabib and Marian Merewitz, sometimes they indicated

On Friday, October 17, 2003, you attempted to intimidate Marian Merewitz and Cintia Cabib of MCT's Training Department. In a calm, civil manner, they requested that you comply with our rules for use of field equipment and attempted to explain those rules to you. You responded with aggressive, confrontational actions and verbal abuse.

This incident is the latest in a series of angry interactions with MCT staff. You have demonstrated repeatedly your unwillingness to comply with our long-established policies on the use of facilities and equipment. Your conduct has disrupted the normal operation of the facilities and has drained time and energy needed to assist other access users. To date, we have tried to accommodate your behavior and to bend the rules for you. However, that accommodation must end.

MCT's basic policy on eligibility to use our facilities states: "MCT may refuse access to eligible users who interfere with the orderly conduct of agency activities." The provision on user conduct states that one of the reasons for refusing access to our facilities is when a user "repeatedly violates policies and procedures established by MCT".


In the past, you have been unwilling to comply with our policies and procedures and to treat our staff with appropriate civility. Therefore, I am suspending your MCT membership for a period of three months. Effective today, you no longer have the privilege of using MCT facilities and equipment.

If you wish to be reinstated after the three-month suspension period, you must write to MCT's incoming Executive Director, Richard Turner, before January 10, 2004, stating that you will comply with MCT's policies and procedures and that you will not yell, threaten, or act in an aggressive manner towards the staff. Upon receipt of this letter, Mr. Turner will confirm that the suspension will be lifted on January 23. If we find thereafter a repetition of past unacceptable behavior, we will pursue the next step of permanent revocation of your access privileges.

You may appeal my decision by writing to the President of the Board of Directors, Nancy Poole, at the MCT office address above. Your letter must be received at MCT within two weeks of the date of this letter. The President will review your appeal with the Executive Committee of the Board and the Committee's decision will be final.

I regret that I must take this action. I hope you will understand my reasons.

FRAUD-CRIME NETWORKS AFFECT MEDIA, MCT

(I). The problems at MCT that I complained previously have been continuing, such as discrimination, obstruction, destruction, damages, harassment, intimidation, etc. that hurt my product, reputation, and the air quality of MCT, as you may be aware of.

(II). My programs have been very seriously adversely tampered, as aired on MCT Channel 19, e.g.:

.1. My studio programs CITIZEN TIMES:

- (A). On Monday 9/20/2004 at 8:30 pm
- (B). On Thursday 9/23/2004 at 4:30 pm.

.2. Problems occurred when airing CITIZEN TIMES: e.g., very nice color combination was changed to very unpleasant for the WHOLE programs:

- (A). Very nice combination of colors with patriot themes were changed to very unpleasant.
- (B). The talk show host was changed to very unpleasant whitish color.
- (C). Beautiful Title page with some red strips, gold stars and gold characters on nice navy background was changed to be on black.
- (D). The host page gold stars and characters on blue was also changed to black.
- (E). The introduction sequences rolls with different color segments were also changed to mainly black or unpleasant dark colors.

.3. There were some countdown from X preceding my programs TITLE page, unlike usually without such countdown.

.4. The problems did not occur in other programs, especially comparing those programs before or after my shows.

.5. Some people saw the problems. Barnard Dowell was also there.

- (A). First, Barnard etc. indicates that was the TV set problems, but it was not.
- (B). Then there was an absurd reasons that Barnard Dowell told people. Barnard said that when he compiled EIGHT programs together, he had to adjust some features to make MCT programs look right, and that turn my program that way. In other words, he has made my program BAD.

(III). The possible tampering and problems on my other program (field project) "AROUND CAPITAL, AROUND US: SOCIAL ISSUES" appeared:

- (A). To be blurry and cloudy as if a translucent layers over the original images.
- (B). Unnecessary vibration than originally produced.
- (C). Such problems seem to occur when editing.

(IV). My work and reputation have been obstructed and damaged; my rights and privileges deprived; constantly under surveillance and hostile environment; being stalked, harassed, intimidated, and humiliated. E.g.:

- .1. My work and use of facilities or edit booths have been unjustly manipulated, obstructed with varieties of problems: e.g. bands, vibration, noises, click sound, etc. Some edit booths with monitors which provides different shades of colors when viewing from different angles.
- .2. It continues to occur, as recent as on and around 8/24/2004, and 9/23/2004.
- .3. Sometimes, it looked like a ghost playing equipment; it moved by itself; sometimes even seemed even to roll backward.
- .4 It appeared that I was most likely to be assigned to edit Booth C:
 - (A). although there were other booths available.
 - (B). Booth C has less equipment than other booth. E.g., no character generator.
 - (C). Booth C constantly gave me a lot of problems, although other booths too.
- .5. Sometimes I was not allowed to book, although other booths were not being reserved, taking into account MCT training classes and their reservation for one or two weeks.
- .6. Whether I used Booth C or other Booths, I was constantly under surveillance and unjust manipulation, and subsequently the problems with the edit facilities occurred.
- .7. Sometimes Larry Merewitz opened the booths that I was using with his keys, instead of knocking at the doors and wait for me to answer or open. Way back before, someone appeared to use a pen-light camera on me.

(V). I have been under surveillance and harassment in other areas too, e.g.:

- .1. On 7/15/2004, around 4:00 pm, I went to MCT kitchen to watch MCT broadcast, Channel 19. Bernard Dowell followed me there. When I turned on TV, he said he wanted to watch other program. Shortly I left, and he left too. When I returned there before 4:30 pm, Bernard Dowell was not there, and so was the remote control.

(VI). The information that I requested have not yet been available or for inspection:

- .1. separate lists of students and graduates of classes (studio and field; producer, technician, and director),
- .2. certified volunteers,
- .3. qualification of the Director of the Board.
- .4. The volunteers who make taping of my candidate statements, especially the one who measure the WRONG time repeatedly.
- .5. The member lists recently received appeared to be arbitrary and tampered.

Some of the problems that I complained before are still there. I hope MCT that serious action to correct them. The following are some examples:

. As you may be aware of, and as I indicated to you before, the edit booth have been unjustly manipulated to obstruct my progress and damage my works. Sometimes, it looks like a ghost playing the computer; it moves by itself; sometimes even seemed to roll backward.

. On the taping of candidate forum, someone improperly exaggerated the length of my statement (nearly 5 minutes instead of 4), and attempted to cut off a significant portion of my statement.

. MCT failed to air my candidate calendar events, as MCT promised. Note that, it is arbitrary and unjust even if MCT did not show calendar events for other candidates, especially when they did not supply as many calendar events or as significant information as I did.

. As I observed, MCT did not use the air time effectively; e.g., on an evening during 7-9 pm, most of the air time was a single frame type of advertisement, except a small portion for candidate statement. Nothing else.

. MCT should have use the time, instead of wasting it to air:

- (1). To air more frequently my studio program "CITIZEN TIMES".
- (2). Conduct and air some issue debates.
- (3). Candidate statements and candidate calendar events, as MCT promised.

As I requested previously, my studio program "CITIZEN TIMES" should be aired more often, at least as often as other programs which have usually aired several rounds. MCT previously had indicated to do so.

. My studio program "CITIZEN TIMES" can be aired two episodes consecutively (about 60 minutes), instead of one episode only (30 minutes) as currently did.

. MCT should make available information on certified volunteers, and graduates of classes (studio and field; producer, technician, and director), as well as qualification of the Director of the Board. I have requested information, but not yet made available.

. These should be readily available. Marian Merewitz told me several months ago that she was working on it, but I have not received them.

. I also asked the names of persons who worked on different positions during the taping of my candidate statements (Primary election 2004). My request was made through Lauree McArdle to Cintia Cabib. I have not received the answer yet.

(III). Related to those people, staff or even volunteers who are in charge or perform the tasks with "MISCONDUCT" and "UNJUST PRACTICES, as those complained previously.

(IV). More importantly, these are related to "official misconduct- government gang- fraud- crime- injustice networks", which cause serious socio-political problems; not just adversely victimized me, but also our society, peace and justice in vicious cycles.

(V). The examples of recent problems, unjust practices, and part of patterns and "fraud- crime- injustice networks" operation are provided below:

(1). MCT broadcast of my studio series "CITIZEN TIMES" has continued to have problems. My program has been unjustly manipulated and adversely impacted.

(2). MCT has not broadcast my program "CITIZEN TIMES" fairly, and continue to have caused confusion and frustration to audience.

(3). MCT has not broadcast my program "CITIZEN TIMES" at 4:00 pm according to "MCT Program Guide".

(4). MCT has not broadcast my program "CITIZEN TIMES", studio series of different episodes with different contents as frequently as other programs, even class projects.

(5). Frequently, MCT cut off my programs on either or both ends with varieties of abuses.

(6). MCT does not even start broadcast of my program at 4:30 p.m. It started unnecessarily a few minutes AFTER 4:30 pm with varieties of abuses, as complained previously.

(7). On 9/25/2003, the airing of my program "CITIZEN TIMES" was manipulated in terrible manners and adverse impacts:

(A). The broadcast of my program "CITIZEN TIMES" was cut short; e.g., WITHOUT THE BEGINNING PORTION, including TITLE, HOST PAGE, and significant portion of INTRODUCTORY, and MUSIC, and cause the discontinuity of the MUSIC.

(B). MCT has unjustly used the "BLACK", "SNOW", or "GRAINY" to cut short or damage my program, and cause adverse impacts on my program and me.

(Related to previous complaints, with numerous issues, including those in 9/5/2003 press release and those previously sent to MCT, including training departments, etc. Some may be unjustly manipulated, influenced.)

(I). MCT broadcast of my studio programs "CITIZEN TIMES" continues to have problems:

- (1). My program did not start at 4:00 pm, and did not start at 4:30 p.m. It started a few minutes after 4:30 pm. This causes confusion and frustration to audience.
- (2). The aired program was cut short without end portion and without credit roll.
- (3). There were some shifts on the screen video images during the airing of my program, unlike what I produced, e.g., about the air time of 4:54-4:57 pm.

(II). Rude, unjust practices, discrimination, victimization, harassment, intimidation continue against me, or attempt to cover-up the problems e.g., those in (I) above.

- (1). I was interrupted to watch TV by MCT staff, especially Bernard Dowell, as he did previously.
- (2). Before and around 4:30 pm, When no one in the kitchen/eating area of the MCT, and no one was watching TV, except me. I turned TV to Montgomery Community Television Channel 19, sat down and watched TV.
- (3). Cintia Cabib came in and left.
- (4). Bernard Dowell came in and interrupted me to watch.
- (3). Bernard Dowell used remote control to change to other channel, e.g., channel 75, without my consent or even asked.
- (4). I opposed his behavior, but was disregarded.
- (5). I told him I was there first, but was still ignored.
- (6). I told him to change to Channel 19, but he would not.

This is to request your immediate approval.

I resent your unjust manipulation and obstruction. You are asking more and more unnecessary stuff. In our last appointment, you mentioned of no such problems.

I was surprised to received your email, concerning the OBSTRUCTION of my project. After all, this evening, we met in the MCT class, you did not discuss, actually did not even mention such unbelievable requirement or DISAPPROVAL.

I hope the following answers will clear your mind or bureaucratic and unjust manipulation or influences by others, especially those "official misconduct- government gang- fraud- crime- injustice networks", which deprive/damage/obstruct people's resources (including time, \$, properties), progress, achievement, etc.

I do not know who you talk to with National Park Services, what you ask. But you certainly have not produced any written information/regulation to support your stringent requirement, when you can easily ask National Park Services to five you or fax to you. It is my believe that either your are asking the wrong thing, or perhaps there is some conspiracies against my project, among you and others, as I mentioned above.

There are certain permits required for certain organizations' events and gathering of certain number of people or more, at certain sites. My project does not applied to those categories, and thus does not require any permit, as many other individuals do, and I did frequently. I also asked National Park Services with phone numbers you gave me and another phone listed in phone book. It is not surprising that the phone number you gave me did not produce good service, as I mentioned to you in my letter previously.

If you really think so, then why did not you ask them for written regulation and ask them to fax a permit form or application to you? After all, it would be helpful for MCT in general, and for other people in particular.

The project is simple, especially you have already cut in half of my project, i.e., October 26-27, 2002, which was no longer possible in my project. The main program now is concentrating on November 14, and cutaways that I have collected, or will continue to collect. Of special interest is to shoot on a special rally event sponsored by other organizations.

The interview question are flexible, as I told you in our appointment on October 21, 2002; mainly to ask people about their concerns, their opinion, or reasons of participation, while the shoot of participants will be able to reflect the different characteristics.

There is no specific script necessary. Generally the formats that I used previously will be considered. Please review my projects: "Twilight of Judiciaries" and "Federal Shambles". I hope these projects are satisfactory. I hope none of the content of my projects upset you. After-all, the content and the purpose of the projects should not be the criteria to be rejected, as outlined in MCT policies.

REQUEST FOR HEARING IN OPEN COURT
JURY TRIAL DEMAND

Petitioners/appellants state as follows:

(I). 1. This pleading is to incorporate with other pleadings in this case and other cases/complaints at administrative and judicial levels (at different government levels) to see the great extent of damages/harms that "official misconduct- government gang- fraud- crime- injustice networks" operation, unjust practices, manipulation, influences and patterns.

1a. All petitioners/appellants pleadings are filed timely.

1b. The court personnel's rulings, not even judges' decisions, are not only arbitrary, but also violations of rules, petitioners/appellants' rights, including litigation rights, civil rights, constitutional, unequal protection, etc.

1c. The court rulings is part of unjust practices, arbitrary disposal of cases, with false excuse without explanation, without time waiting to see the response from the respondent IRS and its government attorneys, and never addressed the issues raised by petitioners/appellants. Actually the Court has not even mentioned any issue at all.

1d. Even in the court short paragraph, there is no explanation at all why the court's "false excuse" of "untimeliness" is indeed correct, despite petitioners/appellants complaints and requests.

1e. Actually, the respondent IRS and its government attorneys practically had never responded to petitioners/appellants' pleadings, and not addressed the issues raised by petitioners/appellants.

1f. This court personnel in this court and lower courts and administrative agencies involved, conspired with and covered up endless immoral, unlawful and criminal acts, bad-faith improper processing of complaints/cases against petitioners/appellants and general taxpayers, at the expense of government resources, justice, peace, etc.

1g. The court system, respondents IRS, or government attorneys have NOT responded to petitioners pleadings, requests; no justification, deliberation, address to issues raised by petitioners.

2. This court, judicial system and government officials should exercise conscience and revisory power to vacate court orders and mandate improper imposed.

3. The judicial systems and administrative agencies and government attorneys should be restructured, reformed; seriously investigate/prosecute/eliminate/abolish "official misconduct- government gang- fraud- crime- injustice networks" operation, unjust practices, influence and patterns.

(II). 4. These pleadings are to be incorporated with other pleadings in this case and other cases, to see the great extent that the respondent/appellee, government attorneys and court personnel and the related fraud-crime-injustice networks operate against citizens like the appellants/petitioners.

4a. These motions are based on very serious repeated and accumulative errors and official misconduct and related "official misconduct- government gang- fraud- crime- injustice networks" operations, unjust practices and patterns by the COURT PERSONNEL, government attorneys and administrative agencies at administrative and judicial levels.

(III) 5. On October 5, 2000, petitioners filed motions/pleadings. Almost immediately, court personnel disposed of it without even waiting for respondent IRS or government attorneys to respond to the petitioners' pleadings, as did and often do by court personnel and "official misconduct- government gang- fraud- crime- injustice networks"; unjust practices and need no effort in litigation or processing of complaints at administration and judicial levels.

5a. The petition was unjustly denied, without justification, or simply with false excuse.

5b. The petition for rehearing and petition for rehearing en banc are also filed timely, but was denied with the reason of "untimely". The court failed to explain why.

5c. Petitioners asked the court to VACATE COURT ORDERS because of serious errors and official misconduct by the court personnel, respondent, its attorneys and related fraud-crime-injustice networks, and have violated petitioners' rights for litigation and protection under the constitution of the U.S. A.

(IV). 6. Petitioners' motion to vacate court orders are more than the motion for RECONSIDERATION, which the court personnel mistakenly and unjustly manipulated in the court order of 9/5/2000. And again without explain or deliberate the reasons of previous court orders, as petitioners disputed, and requested for justification, definite statement and deliberation.

7. The court should have the revisory power to correct the serious errors and official misconduct by the other party, court personnel and related fraud-crime-injustice networks against petitioners.

8. The court personnel's official misconduct and serious errors should be prosecuted and eliminated.

9. Petitioners continue to seek justice, definite statements and deliberation for any decisions and court orders made by this court.

(V). 10. On 8/28/2000, Petitioners filed with the court:

"PETITIONERS MOTIONS:

(1). TO VACATE COURT ORDER OF MANDATE

(2). TO INVESTIGATE, PROSECUTE, SANCTION, ELIMINATE, ABOLISH OFFICIAL MISCONDUCT, GOVERNMENT GANG, FRAUD, CRIME, INJUSTICE AND THEIR NETWORK OPERATIONS, UNJUST PRACTICES, PATTERNS:

11. Petitioners/appellants pointed out emphatically, as did previously:

"The Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit, including administrative judge and court personnel, has repetitively and accumulatively made serious errors like other courts, as parts of "official misconduct- government gang- fraud- crime- injustice networks" operation, unjust practice, discrimination, victimization, retaliation and harassment against people like the petitioners; especially elderly, ill patients and minorities."

"This Court and other court systems have frequently, repetitively and accumulatively to arbitrarily, unjustly and falsely dispose of petitioners' pleadings and documentary evidence; improper docketing, and improper processing of cases, rulings, decisions, and orders."

12. All of petitioners' pleadings have been filed timely, taking into account of mailing services, holidays, weekends as the laws allow.

13. This court has unjustly ruled against petitioners; in favor of improper processing of case, pleadings, docketing, transmitted records by the lower courts, and in favor of arbitrary and false statements by "phony" attorneys for the appellee IRS; all of which are simply parts of "official misconduct- government gang- fraud-crime- injustice networks."

14. This court has also unjustly denied petitioners'

(a). petition for re-hearing

(b). Petition for re-hearing en banc.

14a. Both petition for rehearing and petition for rehearing en banc were filed timely, according to the Court's instruction, taking

into account the mailing services, holidays and weekends, etc., as the laws allow.

14b. The court instruction states that "in all civil cases in which the United States or an agency or officer thereof is a party, the time within which a party may seek rehearing shall be 45 days after entry of judgement." See attached.

14c. The court should be responsible for any error, mistake, misleading or false statements or instruction.

15. On July 19, 2000, this Court denied the petition for rehearing and petitioner for rehearing en banc.

16. On August 9, 2000, petitioners filed:

"(I). Petitioner motion to vacate court order;

(II) Motion to investigate, prosecute and sanction against:

1. Respondent IRS officials and employees;
2. Its attorneys at administrative and judicial levels;
3. Court personnel, clerk, deputy cler, other court
personnel
4. U.S. Tax Court
U.S. Court of Appeals,"

with reasons and arguments, which are self-explanatory. See attached.

17. Neither the respondent IRS, its attorney nor the court has yet properly review or respond the petitioners' pleadings which had been filed timely. On the contrary, they simply arbitrarily and unjustly ruled "untimely" by the court personnel as usual, as if fraud-crime networks easy operation and need no effort at all.

18. The court's unjust and unusual manipulation, improper docketing or failure to docket petitioners' pleadings; made unjust decision and court order to dispose of the case and issue the mandate are unjust; as part of unjust practice of "official misconduct-goverment gang- fraud- crime-injustice networks" operation.

19. Petitioners have been out of town, and was not aware of the court's decision.

20. The court has the revisory power to correct any unjust practices, serious errors, mistakes at any time.

21. MAJOR ISSUES ON APPEAL AND SUPPORTING FACTS AND ARGUMENT, as stated in previous pleadings: (For detail, see pleadings filed with the courts, and attached.):

"1. "OFFICIAL MISCONDUCT- GOVERNMENT GANG- FRAUD- CRIME- INJUSTICE NETWORKS" OPERATION, UNJUST PRACTICES, SCHEMES, MANIPULATION, DISCRIMINATION; CONTINUING, ON-GOING, EXPANDING, PENETRATING; WITH THREATS, COERCION, HARASSMENT, VICITIMIZATION, RETALIATION; ENDLESS IMMORAL, UNLAWFUL AND CRIMINAL ACTS; FROM WIRETAP, SURVEILLANCE, BURGLARY, ROBBERY, HOSTAGE AND RANSOM, CAR-THEFT, FALSE CREDIT DEBT, IDENTITY THEFT, ATTEMPTS OF MURDERS..., WHATEVER; AMONG OFFICIALS, IRS, OPM, SSA, ATTORNEYS (government, private), COURT PERSONNEL, LEGAL OCCUPATIONS; FINANCIAL SERVICES, PAYROLL, BILLING, BENEFIT PROCESSING, CAR-RELATED, PHONE/UTILITIES, PRINTING, CAMPAIGN MATERIALS PRODUCING; HOME IMPROVEMENT... "

22. "The government gang-fraud-crime-injustice networks should be considered as "America's Most Wanted" top list, "cruel tyranny," "robbery machines," which deprive people's rights (including litigation rights), resources (including property, assets, car, banking accounts), reputation, credit ratings, time, etc; defamation, frauds, fogery, car-theft, stealing, burglary, robbery, kinsap, hostage and ransom, attempts of murder, etc. disguised by abuse of laws, false arrests and charges, etc.); cause "fake democracy",

"people-slave," and serious social problems (e.g., racism, classism, poverty, homeless, divisiveness, hate crimes, brutality, violence, etc.); cause "fake democracy," unfair election process, unlawful obstruction of political campaign, etc.; opposite the purposes of education, judicial functions and government function.

23. As stated in previous motions, the official misconduct, unlawful, criminal acts of government officials, employees, and related "official misconduct- government gang- fraud- crime- injustice networks" operation, unjust practices, influences and patterns include:

- ". Unjust, discriminatory practices, harassment, victimization, retaliation.
- . Discredibility, false and arbitrary statements.
- . Misuse/abuse of power, laws and authorities.
- . Unjust and false tax assessment.
- . False lien, false judgment, etc.
- . Lack of job and legal responsibility.
- . Violation of laws, rules, regulation.
- . Violation of taxpayers' bill of rights, constitutional rights, legal rights, liberties and freedom, etc.
- . Denial/disregard petitioners' request for information, even under privacy act, private information, etc.
- . Denial/disregard petitioners' request to inspect the file.
- . Bad-faith, improper procedures, proceedings, file, records, docketing and docket entries, transcripts and tapes.
- . False statements/excusation without justification.
- . Denial/disregard demand for proof, deliberation, justification.
- . failure to address taxpayers' rights and other problems related to tax deficiency notice and hearing/trial:
 - Lack of jurisdiction and legal grounds,
 - Statute of limitation,
 - Due process,
 - Taxpayers' bill of rights,
 - Constitutional rights,
 - Bad-faith, official misconduct;
 - Violation of rules, laws, tax codes.
- Failure to provide information, despite repeated requests.
- . Unjust hearing/trial, and held in unjustly manipulated semi-closed door session.
- . Denial/disregard fair opportunities for appellants' testimony, calling for witnesses/hostile witnesses, examination/cross examination of witnesses/hostile witnesses.

- . Deprive of people's liberties, rights (including litigation rights), resources, reputation, time, credit ratings.
- . Obstruct people's activities: individual, business, political, civic, litigation; destroy the essence of democracy and fair election process;
- . Misleading legislative bills which facilitate fraud-crime operation;
- . Destroy individuals, businesses, communities and peace.
- . From stalking, surveillance, wiretapping, burglary, robbery, theft, car-theft, frauds, medical frauds, brutality, hostage and ransom (disguised by abuse of law, traffic citation, judicial systems, etc.), false credit debt/write-off/identity theft, murders or attempts of murders, ..., create false stereotyping; false charges/arrests/imprisonment/bond, ..., whatever);
- . The official misconduct-government gang-fraud-crime-injustice networks are among different levels of government, public and private sectors; among some officials, judicial system, court personnel (including administrative judge, clerk or deputy clerk of the Court systems), agencies (IRS, OPM, SSA, etc.), attorneys (government and private), businesses (financial institutions, insurance, payment/billing/benefit processing, car-related, printing, campaign material producing; home improvement contractors, plumbers, phone/utilities, ..., etc."

" . The serious official misconduct-government gang-fraud-crime-injustice networks, their operation, unjust and discriminatory practices, frivolous litigation (civil and criminal cases), bad-faith/improper processing of complaints/cases, unlawful and criminal acts, etc., have not been investigated, prosecuted, sanctioned or their jobs abolished/ eliminated."

"2. SERIOUS ERRORS, DISCREDIBILITY, INCOMPETENCY, LACK OF JOB AND LEGAL RESPONSIBILITY, LEGAL DISABILITY, PREJUDICE, BIASNESS, UNJUST AND DISCRIMINATORY PRACTICE."

"3. IRS AND JUDICIAL ACTIONS, RULINGS, DECISIONS TAKEN AGAINST PETITIONERS ARE ILLEGAL AND ERRONEOUS: WITH FALSE STATEMENTS, INCOMPETENT ANALYSIS, AND WITHOUT JUSTIFICATION; BAD-FAITH, UNJUST, IRRELEVANT, IMPROPER, INCORRECT, INACCURATE; UNSUPPORTED BY EVIDENCE, TESTIMONY; AND WITHOUT DELIBERATION AND JUSTIFICATION; DISCREDIBILITY, INCOMPETENCY, LACK OF JOB AND LEGAL RESPONSIBILITY, LEGAL DISABILITY, PREJUDICE, BIASNESS, UNJUST AND DISCRIMINATORY PRACTICE; UNJUST AND DISCRIMINATORY PRACTICES: BAD-FAITH, INACCESSIBLE, UNAVAILABLE OF PERTINENT INFORMATION ON COURT PROCEDURES, TRANSCRIPTS AND TAPES, PHOTOCOPYING, ETC."

"4. IMPROPER PROCESSING AND UNJUST DISPOSAL OF PETITIONERS' MOTIONS, PLEADINGS, DOCUMENTARY EVIDENCE WITHOUT ENTERING THE DOCKET ENTRIES, AND WITHOUT ADDRESSING ISSUES; RESPONDENT AND ITS ATTORNEYS HAVE TOTALLY DISREGARDED AND FAILED TO RESPOND TO ISSUES RAISED BY THE PETITIONERS; IMPROPER RULINGS, PROCESSING OF COMPLAINT, PLEADINGS, DOCKETING, INFORMATION, ETC.; GROSS OFFICIAL MISCONDUCT, CONSPIRACIES, AMONG COURT SYSTEM, IRS, FRAUD-CRIME-INJUSTICE NETWORKS; IMPROPER

PROCESSING AND UNJUST DISPOSAL OF PETITIONERS' MOTIONS WITHOUT ENTERING THE DOCKET ENTRIES, AND WITHOUT ADDRESSING ISSUES; IRRESPONSIVENESS, INSENSITIVENESS; ARBITRARY PROCEDURES, VIOLATION OF TAX CODES, REGULATION; PROHIBIT USE OF TAX COURT LIBRARY; REFUSE TO PROVIDE INFORMATION AND SOURCES REGARDING TRANSCRIPT AND TAPES; FACILITATE FRAUD-CRIME-INJUSTICE NETWORKS OPERATION AND UNJUST PRACTICES BY COURT PERSONNEL, RESPONDENT IRS, ITS ATTORNEYS."

. "APPELLANT APPENDIX TO INFORMAL BRIEF - IMPROPERLY PROCESSED AND UNTRANSMITTED IN THE RECORD" contain examples of the pleadings with attachments, documentary evidence, and information which are improperly disposed of by the U.S. Tax Court with incorrect docket entries and record to conceal unjust practices, official misconduct by appellee, government attorneys and related official misconduct-government gang-fraud-crime-injustice networks (including Administrative Judge, Clerk and Deputy Clerk of the Court, and other court personnel). Issues raised by petitioners/appellants are disregarded, including numerous serious official misconduct, unjust and discriminatory practices, threats and coercion."

". Judicial proceedings are usually for "formality only," with unjust fees structures, improper procedures and proceedings, harassment and coercion, etc., to further victimize and retaliate against appellants or complainants, and to facilitate official misconduct, wrongdoings, and unjust and discriminatory practices, as by appellees, its attorneys and related "official misconduct-government gang-fraud-crime-injustice networks":

". ". Lower court has not transmitted complete records to the Court of Appeal. Thus it has unjustly concealed something and committed improper procedures and proceedings, and as parts of unjust practices and patterns, despite appellants' repeated complaints and expressed concerns in their previous pleading (motions to schedule properly and to extend in time) as filed with U.S. Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit. Unfortunately, both lower court and the Court of Appeals failed to correct that. Appellants have not received correction on transmission of records from either court."

". U. S. Court of Appeal has failed to supervise properly the transmission of "complete" records, despite appellants strongly and clearly stated in their motions to schedule properly, and sought to review the complete records, transcript and tapes."

". Appellants ask the Court of Appeals in pursuit of "justice," not to blindly agrees with lower court's errors, wrongdoings, or disregards of the critical responsibility of the Court."

Destruction of: individuals, families, communities, peace, democracy, fair election process

Obstruction of political campaign and civic activities

Like Robbery Machines, create social problems: poverty, divisiveness, hate crimes, fake democracy, etc.

Unnecessary medical, hospital or mental services;

False arrests, charges, imprisonment;

Abuse and retaliation with false excuses, e.g.:

False traffic citations, contempt of order, bonds and fines;..."

". Fees structures and improper processing of complaints and litigations in judicial systems are at the expense of appellants/complainants and social justice, as compared with warchest

(collected from general public or taxpayers) which are misused and abused by appellees, government attorneys, and related official misconduct-government gang-fraud-crime-injustice networks. People are unprotected and unequally protected."

"5. UNJUST PRACTICES, MISMANAGEMENT, AND LACK OF ELEMENTARY SCHOOL IQ TO FACILITATE "OFFICIAL MISCONDUCT- GOVERNMENT GANG- FRAUD- CRIME- INJUSTICE NETWORKS:"

". SECRET SUBMISSION OF TRANSCRIPT WITHOUT SENDING A COPY TO PETITIONERS, AND WOULD NOT PROVIDE TAPES AND OTHER INFORMATION REGULATING THE AVAILABILITY, ACCESSIBILITY AND PHOTOCOPYING OF COURT FILE, TRANSCRIPT AND TAPES:"

"6. JUDICIAL REVISORY POWER, CORRECTION AND SANCTION AGAINST RESPONDENT, ITS ATTORNEYS, OFFICIAL MISCONDUCT, GOVERNMENT GANG- FRAUD-CRIME-INJUSTICE NETWORKS:

. Judicial revisory power, corrective actions, and sanction against respondent, its attorneys, judge, court personnel, and related government gang-fraud-crime networks are necessary, but often often fail to do."

. Respondent, its attorneys, and Judicial system often evidenced with judicial disability, bias, prejudice, lack of legal and judicial responsibility, as parts of unjust and discriminatory practices, and related fraud-crime-injustice networks.

. Taxpayers, like petitioners have suffered from a variety of abuses, crimes, unlawful acts by officials-government gang-fraud-crime-injustice networks; from local, county, state, federal to oversea; including Office of Personnel Management, employee benefits/ payroll/billing processing.

. Incorporate all pleadings, "APPELLANT APPENDIX TO INFORMAL BRIEF - IMPROPERLY PROCESSED AND UNTRANSMITTED IN RECORDS," all facts, statements, documentary evidence in this and other cases/complaints at administrative and judicial levels to see a better picture about official misconduct-fraud-crime-injustice by appellee IRS, government attorneys and related fraud-crime-injustice network.

. Appellants have not received statements or documents certifying the complete records (including exhibits) are indeed transmitted to the Court of Appeals, in "just" and "appropriate manners." As stated in appellants' previous pleading filed with Court of Appeals to reschedule properly, these should include but are not limited to:

(A). Complete proceedings and records, including transcript and tapes, files, exhibits, docket entries, etc.

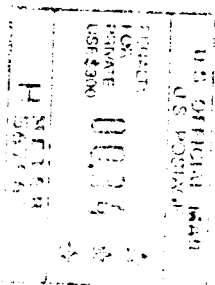
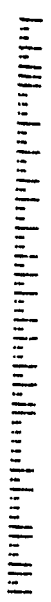

This Court's Local Rule 40(d) states that, except for timely petitions for rehearing en banc, cost and attorney fee matters, and other matters ancillary to the filing of an application for writ of certiorari with the Supreme Court, the Office of the Clerk shall not receive motions or other papers requesting further relief in a case after the Court has denied a petition for rehearing or the time for filing a petition for rehearing has expired.

Pursuant to the provisions of Local Rule 40(d), no further action will be taken in this matter.
