Dear Mr. Kaizen,

Although I've written to you in the past, February 7, 2005, return receipt signed for on February 18, 2005, regarding the President's Advisory Panel on Federal Tax Reform, I have learned that the "Panel" will not sit down and read the entire 21 page report on liability. Therefore I, and a group of concerned American citizens, feel that it's extremely important that you and the "Panel" become aware of the entire 21 page report.

Enclosed you'll find three pages, 16, 17, & 18 of that report. These three pages alone should convince you, and the rest of the "Panel", that a direct tax without apportionment on a private citizen's earnings is not only contrary to established law but also immoral. Not to mention the Internal Revenue's complete disregard for due process in the collection of this alleged tax liability.

The American public is becoming increasingly aware of the gross misapplication of the tax laws in this country and anything short of complete compliance with the Constitutional requirements and restrictions on Government Officials and those acting in their behalf is being regarded with a great deal of hostility and lack of confidence in the Federal Government.

I hope you, and the rest of the "Panel" will get the message that this letter, with the attachment, and the other letters you'll receive, that we are trying to convey in a lawful and peaceful manner.
