Greetings,

This treatise on Income Tax is submitted for your consideration.

POSTULATES

1.0. Each entity (people, corporations) that acquires wealth from some activity within the nation will be taxed a portion of that income (acquired wealth).

1.1. Every entity will be taxed to support the government of the nation that made it possible for them to acquire that wealth.

(A National Sales Tax to finance the government does not conform to this postulate. A National Sales Tax will be used to reduce sales - to slow the economy and to reduce inflation, www.sales-tax.ws)

2.0. The tax rate will be in proportion to the amount of income.

2.1. A formula will be used that will increase the tax rate the same for all levels of income. This will produce a straight line, a chart is included. The more an entity benefits from the economic system, the higher the tax rate.

2.2. Under the current tax bracket system the effective tax rate increases faster on low and middle incomes than it does on high incomes. This creates a negatively accelerating curve, a chart is included.

3.0. Each income level will be taxed the same regardless of the source of the income.

3.1. Under the current system, the same amount of income is taxed at a different rate depending on the source of that income, e.g. wages, investments, profits, inheritance, etc.

4.0. This tax system will be used to maintain civil order. Civil disorder follows when a few people accumulate the wealth of a nation, e.g. the French Revolution, the Russian Revolution.

5.0. This tax system is constructed so that productive behavior is reinforced, but hoarding behavior is not reinforced.

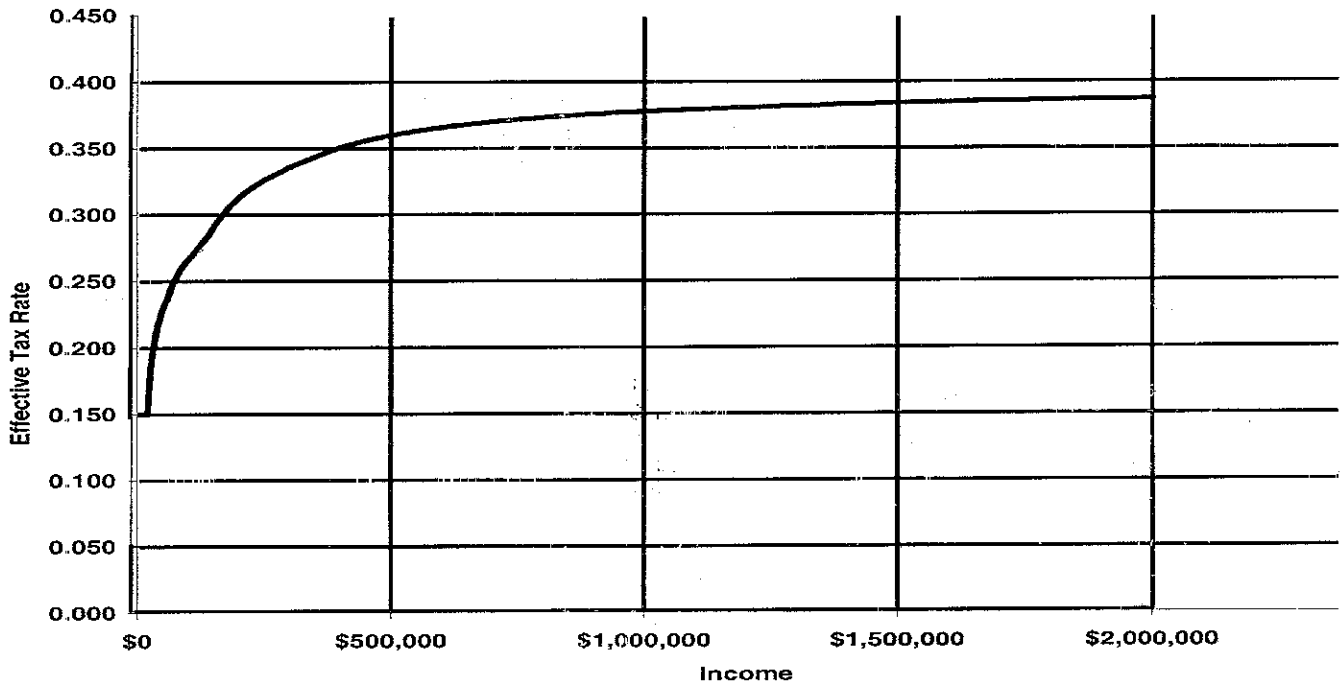

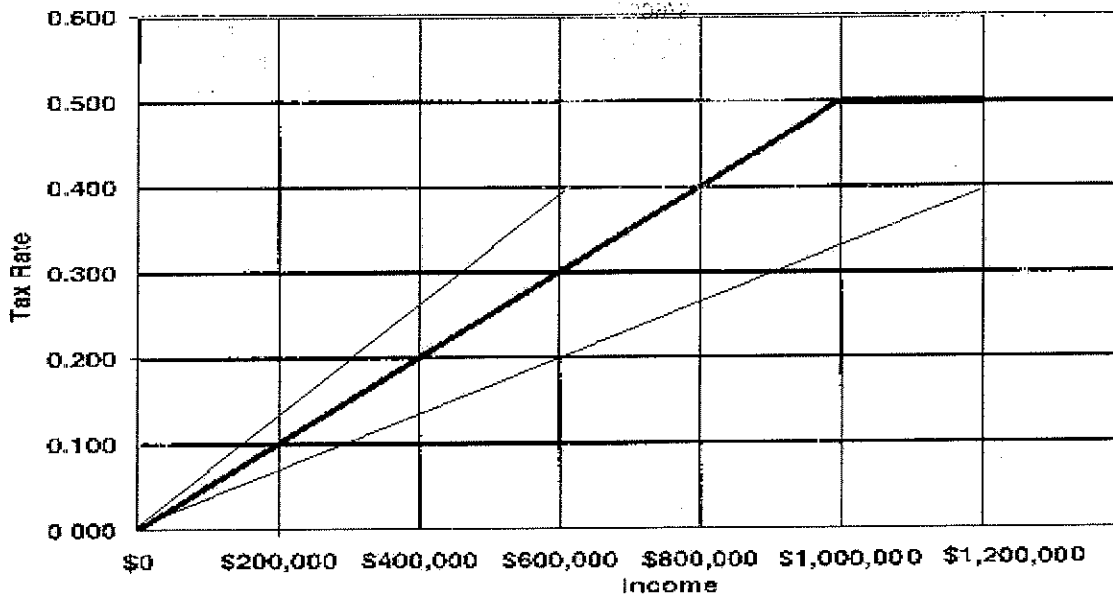
1. A graph of the effective tax rates that results from the current income tax brackets. Notice how quickly the rates rise on low and middle incomes.

Effective Tax Rates Using Current Tax Brackets
The Tax Rate Increases Much Faster For Poor People Than It Does For Rich People
Compare the Chart for Constant Increasing Rate



2. A graph of the tax rates using a formula that treats all income levels the same. The maximum rate will be determined by Congress. The steepness of the curve will be determined by Congress. Three lines are on the chart as examples. The formula is simple enough for any taxpayers to enter into a cheap calculator.
